·E.	X	Other Recommendation and Comments: In the area of opportunities, data and responses indicate that the standard established in Tests 1 and 3 are being met. The report does not show that the indicated interest in girls soccer has been pursued in order to verify compliance. Therefore, it is questionable that the standard established in Test 3 has been met. In the area of benefits, total athletic spending still favors male athletes on both a percentage and per athlete basis. This disparity has continued over a two-year period. The current Corrective Action Plan does call for oversight of spending for the provision of parity. It would appear at this point that more stringent measures are needed in order to bring about equity.
