E	X	Other Recommendation and Comments: All calculations appear to be correct, and the report is in good order. According to data submitted, the school is meeting the standard established in Test 1 for the provision of athletic opportunities. The documentation provided in relation to addressing the interest in girls swimming indicates that the standard established in Test 3 is also being met. In the area of benefits, total athletic spending is outside of acceptable parameters on both a percentage and a per athlete basis. School officials need to closely monitor athletic spending for provision of equity so this disparity does not continue over a two-year period.

- 2) Add the total number of girls and boys enrolled to determine total enrollment, (place in Row 3, Column 1).
- 3) Calculate the percentage of total enrollment that is female. (Divide Row 1, Column 1 by Row 3, Column 1 and place in Row 1, Column 2.) Calculate the percentage of total enrollment that is male. (Divide Row 2, Column 1 by Row 3, Column 1 and place in Row 2, Column 2.) Note: Row 1, Column 2 plus Row 2, Column 2 should total 100%.
- Ask coaches to confirm the names of those individuals who are on the team as of the first date of regular season competition, and cross out the names of those who were cut from the team or quit the team prior to the first regular season competitive event. Note: While being within three percent is <u>not</u> a formal compliance standard, if the percent listed in Row 1, Column 4 is within 3% of Row 1, Column 2, then it provides a good target within which compliance is likely.
