The KHSAA continues to recommend that a meeting of the Gender Equity Review Committee be held in each of the three sport seasons: Fall, Winter, and Spring.
The differential between total spending for male and female teams on this report was out of proportion to the number of participants. The amount spent per athlete was \$803 for boys and \$448 for girls, a difference of \$355. KHSAA guidelines recognize a difference of \$100 per male athlete for schools with football teams as within compliance standards. Please provide a statement of explanation for the high differential on this report, by May 31, 2010
