The responses on the T-3 form seem to be supported by information compiled from the most recent student athletic interest survey. In the area of benefits, it does not appear that a full accounting of travel expenditures is included on the T-35 and T-36 forms. A discussion with the school's athletic director confirms this statement. School officials are reminded that all expenditures for travel and per diem are to be listed on the T-35 and T-36 forms beginning with the 2010-2011 annual report. Expenditures submitted on this report do appear to be within acceptable parameters for the provision of parity.
