E.	x	Other Recommendation and Comments:The data and responses submitted indicate that the standard established in both test #1 and test #3 for provision of athletic opportunities is currently being met. The report documents no steps taken to validate the indicated interests shown on the most recent student athletic interest survey. Therefore, compliance with test #3 cannot be verified at this time. In relation to benefits, total athletic spending appears to favor the male athletes. Monitoring of athletic spending in relation to provision of equitable benefits should be a priority for both the G.E.R.C. and school administrators.

- Determine the total number of girls enrolled, (place in Row 1, Column 1).
 Determine the total number of boys enrolled, (place in Row 2, Column 1).
- 2) Add the total number of girls and boys enrolled to determine total enrollment, (place in Row 3, Column 1).
- Calculate the percentage of total enrollment that is female. (Divide Row 1, Column 1 by Row 3, Column 1 and place in Row 1, Column 2.) Calculate the percentage of total enrollment that is male. (Divide Row 2, Column 1 by Row 3, Column 1 and place in Row 2, Column 2.) Note: Row 1, Column 2 plus Row 2, Column 2 should total 100%.
