Instructions: *Number of 8th grade students & below used in Column 3 and Column 4 calculations: 53

- 1) Determine the total number of girls enrolled, (place in Row 1, Column 1). Determine the total number of boys enrolled, (place in Row 2, Column 1).
- 2) Add the total number of girls and boys enrolled to determine total enrollment, (place in Row 3, Column 1).
- 3) Calculate the percentage of total enrollment that is female. (Divide Row 1, Column 1 by Row 3, Column 1 and place in Row 1, Column 2.) Calculate the percentage of total enrollment that is male. (Divide Row 2, Column 1 by Row 3, Column 1 and place in Row 2, Column 2.) Note: Row 1, Column 2 plus Row 2, Column 2 should total 100%.
- 4) Ask coaches to confirm the names of those individuals who are on the team as of the first **date of regular season competition**, and cross out the names of those who were cut from the team or quit the team prior to the first regular season competitive event. Determine the total number of interscholastic athletics participants that are girls, (and place in Row 1, Column 3). In order to determine the total number of athletics participants, an individual should be counted each time he or she participates on a team. For example, if Jane Doe competes on the varsity volleyball team, the junior varsity volleyball team, the junior varsity basketball team, and the varsity softball team, she should be counted as four participants (**do not include club or intramural sports participants, cheerleaders, dance teams, or pom squads**). Calculate the same way for boys and girls. * In addition, should 8th grade students and below play on a Freshman, Junior Varsity, or Varsity team, they should also be counted for each team and sport on which they participate. If applicable, please asterisk in the above notation as to how many 8th grade students & below are included in the totals.
Using the same procedure, determine the total number of interscholastic athletic participants that are boys, (and place in Row 2, Column 3). Add Row 1, Column 3 plus Row 2, Column 3 to get total participants and place in Row 3, Column 3.
- 5) Calculate the percentage of female participation. (Row 1, Column 3 divided by Row 3, Column 3 and place in Row 1, Column 4.) Calculate the percentage of male participation. (Row 2, Column 3 divided by Row 3, Column 3 and place in Row 2, Column 4.) Note: Row 1, Column 4 plus Row 2, Column 4 should total 100%.

Note: While being within three percent is not a formal compliance standard, if the percent listed in Row 1, Column 4 is within 3% of Row 1, Column 2, then it provides a good target within which compliance is likely.

The biggest hindrance continues to be a lack of adequate facilities to hold practices or matches. The only Tennis courts in the county are located at the local industrial park, and they aren't in good enough shape to use. Over the past year, we have discussed to possibility of repairing the courts with county officials, but they claim that the park board doesn't have the funds at this time to participate in the tennis court renovation. The district has a planned construction project for the high school in the next year, and is studying the option of working a tennis facility into that project. Once we are able to overcome the facilities issue, a meeting will be schedule to assess the depth of interest in adding Tennis as a competitive sport at the high school level. Other suggestions (i.e. Archery, Bass Fishing, & Wrestling) are not viable at the present time due to the proximity of our district to other districts that offer the sport. Hopefully Archery or Bass Fishing can be added for both genders in the next couple years.</p>
