5. Describe your plans to address interest below:

Adair County High School did not meet the Test 3 last year. To become satisfactory on the test and meet the test, ACHS held student follow up interest meetings for the following sports on December 14, 2012 and January 3, 2013: Girls soccer, Boys Soccer, Boys and Girls Archery, Boys and Girls Bowling, and Girls Cross Country. On January 3, 2013 the meetings were held for students and parents. For both days, there were a total of three students and one parent that attended. Therefore, there was not sufficient interest to move forward in the follow up procedures. Documentation was sent to KHSAA and approved.

Also, based on the most recent survey (March 2013), the results showed a reasonably high interest in the following sports: Archery (B/G), Bass Fishing (B/G), Soccer (B/G), Swimming (B/G), Wrestling. ACHS offered an initial follow up interest meeting for each of the above mentioned sports on April 22, 2013. The meeting was held in the ACHS Cafeteria at 4:00 pm CST. During the meeting only one student attended. This student showed interest in Bass Fishing and Archery. This however does not provide enough interest to pursue the addition of any of the above mentioned sports at this time. ACHS will conduct the Interest Survey again next year, follow up if necessary, and take appropriate steps to get back on track for the even year rotation.
