This, along with the fact that the closest usable tennis court is 20 miles from Breckinridge County High School indicates there is not viable interest in creating a girls\'' tennis team.</p> <p>Interest meetings for girls track were held on Aug 29, 2012, Sept 12, 2012, and April 11, 2013. Respectively, 7, 1, and 2 students attended. This indicates there is not viable interest in forming a girls track team at this time.</p> <p>BCHS will monitor this situation to ensure proper steps are followed should viable interest be demonstrated.</p>
