- 1) Determine the total number of girls enrolled, (place in Row 1, Column 1). Determine the total number of boys enrolled, (place in Row 2, Column 1).
- 2) Add the total number of girls and boys enrolled to determine total enrollment, (place in Row 3, Column 1).
- 3) Calculate the percentage of total enrollment that is female. (Divide Row 1, Column 1 by Row 3, Column 1 and place in Row 1, Column 2.) Calculate the percentage of total enrollment that is male. (Divide Row 2, Column 1 by Row 3, Column 1 and place in Row 2, Column 2.) Note: Row 1, Column 2 plus Row 2, Column 2 should total 100%.
- 4) Ask coaches to confirm the names of those individuals who are on the team as of the first **date of regular season competition**, and cross out the names of those who were cut from the team or quit the team prior to the first regular season competitive event. Determine the total number of interscholastic athletics participants that are girls, (and place in Row 1, Column 3). In order to determine the total number of athletics participants, an individual should be counted each time he or she participates on a team. For example, if Jane Doe competes on the varsity volleyball team, the junior varsity volleyball team, the junior varsity basketball team, and the varsity softball team, she should be counted as four participants (**do not include club or intramural sports participants, cheerleaders, dance teams, or pom squads**). Calculate the same way for boys and girls. * In addition, should 8th grade students and below play on a Freshman, Junior Varsity, or Varsity team, they should also be counted for each team and sport on which they participate. If applicable, please asterisk in the above notation as to how many 8th grade students & below are included in the totals.
Using the same procedure, determine the total number of interscholastic athletic participants that are boys, (and place in Row 2, Column 3). Add Row 1, Column 3 plus Row 2, Column 3 to get total participants and place in Row 3, Column 3.
- 5) Calculate the percentage of female participation. (Row 1, Column 3 divided by Row 3, Column 3 and place in Row 1, Column 4.) Calculate the percentage of male participation. (Row 2, Column 3 divided by Row 3, Column 3 and place in Row 2, Column 4.) Note: Row 1, Column 4 plus Row 2, Column 4 should total 100%.

Note: While being within three percent is not a formal compliance standard, if the percent listed in Row 1, Column 4 is within 3% of Row 1, Column 2, then it provides a good target within which compliance is likely.

5. Describe your plans to address interest below:

We are going to check around the area to find out if there are enough other schools that plan to have competitive archery and bowling teams. We recently have added Bass Fishing as a competitive sport during the 2012-13 school year. Our Gender Equity Review Committee met to address the student interest in Bowling and Archery, based on our most recent student surveys, and discussed the possibility of adding both to our competitive sports programs here at Johnson Central High School. The Committee decided to add Bowling as a club activity at our school for the 2012-13 school year and to continue gauging interest from students, parents, and community members. The committee also made a recommendation, in conjunction with our local bowling alley, to allow students to participate in a local recreational bowling league to further gauge such interest. Logistically, there are very few schools in our geographic area that offer bowling as a competitive sport. At the current time, there are not enough competitive teams within a reasonable driving distance to form a school team. The GERC decided ultimately to keep bowling as a club activity at the school until more schools offer teams to compete. In addition, our principal has had meetings and discussions with the proprietor of the local bowling alley to discuss usage agreements, practice/competition schedules, and possible coaching opportunities for when Bowling is added as a competitive sport at our High School. Upon completion of those discussions, and also considering our students' interest based on recent surveys, we have decided to also incorporate bowling as an intramural activity to further gauge viable interest in hopes of adding a bowling team to our athletics program as a competitive sport in the near future. The GERC also made a recommendation to integrate Archery into the Physical Education Curriculum at Johnson Central High School. Meetings with Parents, Students, and Community Members have been scheduled to further gauge interest in Archery to see if the interest is viable.
