- 2) Add the total number of girls and boys enrolled to determine total enrollment, (place in Row 3, Column 1).
- 3) Calculate the percentage of total enrollment that is female. (Divide Row 1, Column 1 by Row 3, Column 1 and place in Row 1, Column 2.) Calculate the percentage of total enrollment that is male. (Divide Row 2, Column 1 by Row 3, Column 1 and place in Row 2, Column 2.) Note: Row 1, Column 2 plus Row 2, Column 2 should total 100%.
- 4) Ask coaches to confirm the names of those individuals who are on the team as of the first **date of regular season competition**, and cross out the names of those who were cut from the team or quit the team prior to the first regular season competitive event. Determine the total number of interscholastic athletics participants that are girls, (and place in Row 1, Column 3). In order to determine the total number of athletics participants, an individual should be counted each time he or she participates on a team. For example, if Jane Doe competes on the varsity volleyball team, the junior varsity volleyball team, the junior varsity basketball team, and the varsity softball team, she should be counted as four participants (**do not include club or intramural sports participants, cheerleaders, dance teams, or pom squads**). Calculate the same way for boys and girls. * In addition, should 8th grade students and below play on a Freshman, Junior Varsity, or Varsity team, they should also be counted for each team and sport on which they participate. Note: While being within three percent is not a formal compliance standard, if the percent listed in Row 1, Column 4 is within 3% of Row 1, Column 2, then it provides a good target within which compliance is likely.

In the Fall of the 2013-2014 school year, we will conduct another Student Interest Survey to gauge student interest in sports not currently offered. If the Gender Equity Committee agrees that there appears to be sufficient student interest in a bowling team, interest meetings will be conducted with students and parents, and an attempt to find a school sponsor will take place during the 2013-2014 school year. The school will also do a study of schools in our geographic region, who participate in the sport of bowling, but who also has to travel out-of-county for a bowling facility. The GEC would then determine if the sport of bowling is cost efficient for our current school athletic budget.</p>
