- 3) Calculate the percentage of total enrollment that is female. (Divide Row 1, Column 1 by Row 3, Column 1 and place in Row 1, Column 2.) Calculate the percentage of total enrollment that is male. In order to determine the total number of athletics participants, an individual should be counted each time he or she participates on a team.
