5. Describe your plans to address interest below:

Based on the most recent Athletic Interest Survey, (April 2014) the results showed a reasonably high interest in the following sports or sport activities: Archery, Bass Fishing, Bowling, Cross Country, Soccer, Swimming, and Wrestling. There was no distinguishing between male/female for these sports from the survey. Since there was a high interest shown in the survey, Adair County High School offered an initial follow up meeting for anyone interested in participating in any of the sports listed above. The meeting was held in the ACHS library on April 28, 2014 at 4:00 pm CST. The meeting did not provide enough interest was in the sport activity of Bass Fishing. Due to the lack of interest, there is not sufficient interest to add any of the above listed sports. Brent Campbell, Athletic Director and Troy Young, Principal were available to provide information when needed. The sign in sheets are available if needed.

From question number 4 above, there would be enough teams in our area to make a competitive schedule. However, due to the lack of interest shown during the interest meeting, ACHS will not be able to add the listed sports for the 2014-2015 school year therefore we would not have a competitive schedule.

Also, the 2013-2014 survey is the second of the two consecutive years for administering the Student Survey. This should allow Adair County High School to return to the correct year rotation for administering the survey as all other KHSAA member schools.
