Along with this T65 form, you have also received a copy of a revised Title IX Internal Audit Summary for this school. It is important that you review all of the details concerning the analysis of the report submitted.

The Internal Audit Summary will analyze all parts of the three-part test for Title IX compliance, based on a snapshot of the data on the date submitted. Those conclusions are listed. Revisions have been made in this form to clarify the calculation of the underrepresented gender and ensure the preservation of the integrity of the foundational purposes of Title IX. The form also continues to contain notes made to help you determine how calculations were derived and detail the exclusion of certain elements related to Archery and Bass Fishing which are true coed sport-activities.

In the first section you will note many factors such as per total participation, total expenditures, participant spending (per gender), and many other factors to be considered as you move forward with future planning. You will also note on Row 13, the determination of the underrepresented gender in your school. This is a critical element in determining Title IX compliance.

The Test 1 (traditionally called the "numbers" test) section again contains guidance as to the number of new participants in the underrepresented gender needed to meet this test. Explanatory notes in the right column should help verify the calculations, which were done by the system based on the submitted data.

The Test 2 (traditionally called the "recent history of expanding sport offerings for the underrepresented gender" test) section contains the information for Test 2 and the calculations were done solely by the system based on the submitted data.

The Test 3 (traditionally called the "accommodating interest and abilities" test) section contains the information for Test 3. This is determined by the audit team based on the analysis of the data provided.

At the bottom of the Title IX Internal Audit Summary is a summary conclusion as to whether or not the school appears to be in compliance with one of the three parts of the tests for Title IX compliance. The questions above are answered based on the information from the student interest survey administered for the year of 2017-2018. Based on this survey, there was a sufficient amount of interest in the sports of Cross Country, Dance, Soccer, Archery, Bowling, Wrestling, and Bass Fishing to pursue the possibility of adding team(s) in the mentioned sports. A student interest meeting was held last year in May 2018 to determine if there was enough interest to add any sports for the 2018-19 school year. The meeting was held after school on the Adair County High School cafeteria at 4:00 cst. There were two students that attended the meeting. One student was interested in girls cross country and the other in boys cross country and bass fishing. Based on the turnout for the meeting, administration did not think interest was high enough to continue the process for the addition of teams. Using the numbers from this same survey, there was another interest meeting scheduled to see if there

Using the numbers from this same survey, there was another interest meeting scheduled to see if there was still any or enough interest in the sports mentioned above to continue with the process of adding teams in any or all of the sports for the 2019-2020 school year. The meeting was held in the ACHS cafeteria on Wednesday April 10, 2019 at 4:00 p.m. cst. School announcements were made days before the meeting via calendar, intercom system, and the school tv news. The outcome of the meeting did not show enough interest to pursue the addition of new teams to the athletic program. There was only one student that attended the meeting in favor of boys cross country. However, there were four other students that talked to me on the following day showing interest but were not able to attend due to scheduling conflicts. Three of the four were interested in cross country and the other was interested in bass fishing. A sign-up sheet is available to document the small amount of interest for the addition of new sports. At this time, we (administration) do not think there is enough interest in the mentioned

new sports. At this time, we (administration) do not think there is enough interest in the mentioned sports to pursue the addition of teams in the sports listed in question #1. Even though interest was low, as Athletic Director, I will discuss with school administration once again to see if there is a need to have a follow up meeting for the sport of cross country.

If a follow up meeting is deemed necessary, it will involve the athletes and parents along with administration. This Q/A session will take place before a cross country team is formed. If we move forward with Cross County, we will take the appropriate steps to add the sport and also competes a competitive schedule to begin in the fall of 2019-2020.

Adair County will continue to regularly monitor and evaluate the amount of student interest in adding
