Along with this T65 form, you have also received a copy of a revised Title IX Internal Audit Summary for this school. It is important that you review all of the details concerning the analysis of the report submitted.

The Internal Audit Summary will analyze parts 1 and 2 of the three-part test for Title IX compliance, based on a snapshot of the data on the date submitted. Those conclusions are listed. As a result of Covid 19, no determination will be made as to compliance with Test 3. Revisions have been made in this form to clarify the calculation of the underrepresented gender and ensure the preservation of the integrity of the foundational purposes of Title IX. The form also continues to contain notes made to help you determine how calculations were derived and detail the exclusion of certain elements related to Archery, Bass Fishing, and Esports which are true coed sport-activities.

In the first section you will note many factors such as per total participation, total expenditures, participant spending (per gender), and many other factors to be considered as you move forward with future planning. You will also note on Row 13, the determination of the underrepresented gender in your school. This is a critical element in determining Title IX compliance.

The Test 1 (traditionally called the "numbers" test) section again contains guidance as to the number of new participants in the underrepresented gender needed to meet this test. Explanatory notes in the right column should help verify the calculations, which were done by the system based on the submitted data.

The Test 2 (traditionally called the "recent history of expanding sport offerings for the underrepresented gender" test) section contains the information for Test 2 and the calculations were done solely by the system based on the submitted data.

The Test 3 (traditionally called the "accommodating interest and abilities" test) section contains the information for Test 3. This is determined by the audit team based on the analysis of the data provided, but will not be analyzed this year as a result of Covid 19.

At the bottom of the Title IX Internal Audit Summary is a summary conclusion as to whether or not the school appears to be in compliance with one of the three parts of the tests for Title IX compliance. #### 5. Describe your plans to address interest below:

This information is based on the results of the student interest survey administered in the fall of 2019. Based on the survey, there was interest in Field Hockey, Bass Fishing and Esports. We had several interest meeting in the spring of 2018 to evaluate adding bass fishing. After those meetings, we formed a team during the 2018-2019 school year. At the time of the interest meetings, we had 20-30 people at the meetings. When we actually formed the team, we only had 10 that came out. The 10 were all males, unlike the interest meeting when we had a few females interested. Of the 10 males, several were seniors in 2018-2019 and graduated. We did not continue the bass fishing program this year as there was not enough interest to keep it going. After the 2018-2019 school year ended, we were in communication with those in the program and there was not enough interest for it to continue in 2019-2020. We will continue to evaluate the interest level of bass fishing to see if it makes sense to bring the program back.

Based on this recent survey, we have 14 interested in girls field hockey. We will continue in this process in the fall to further investigate the level of interest... we will have interest meetings, etc to determine the true level of interest while also realizing as a smaller school that offers 12 sports to females, we must balance what we offer with the number of females we have to ensure we are not taking girls from other teams in order to field a team.

The third and final sport that generated interest from our survey, was esports. As we gather back in the fall for 2020 we will also investigate the true level of interest while also ensuring we are able to provide high quality resources to our already existing programs.
