Coaching	Х		It appears that all the student athletes at Bullitt East are receiving quality coaches at all levels in all sports. It is noted that a large number of the coaches are paraprofessional and off campus.
Locker Rooms, Practice and Competitive Facilities	Х		Lack of rest room at softball is an area that needs to be addressed by the Gender Equity Committee and the School Board.

Medical and Training Facilities and Services	X	It appears that the student athletes in all sports are treated equally in regard to physicals. A trainer and student trainers are available for all the athletes at Bullitt East. The Weight Room is scheduled for both male and female athletes. The Gender Equity Committee needs to evaluate the weight room yearly to make sure it stays female friendly. The weight room has some lighting issues that may well cause some problems in regard to safety issues.
Publicity	X	It appears that all the sports teams at Bullitt East are treated equally in this area. Gender Equity Committee needs to develop a policy for displaying banners, jerseys, pictures and trophies. In this policy would be how banquets and honors programs would be held to recognize teams as well as individual athletes.
Support Services	Х	The Gender Equity Committee needs to look over the Yearly Report prepared by the Athletic Director to double check that all budget expenses are being reported correctly, especially in regard to travel and awards.

5. Brief Summary/Analysis of the Corrective Action Plan (Form T-60)

➤ Bullitt East High School is providing some excellent opportunities for the student athletes. As the Student Interest Surveys have shown an interest in adding sports the school has taken steps to see if this interest is real and genuine and as a result of these efforts no sports have been added to the offerings at the school.

6. Observed Deficiencies in Overall Girls and Boys Athletics Programs

- Although not deficient at this time the Gender Equity Committee needs to tour the facilities and locker rooms and make note of any differences and set forth any corrective action to make sure that the boys and girls at North Bullitt are getting the same equal treatment. This should be evaluated on a yearly basis.
- > The school has made some improvements since the original visit, especially correcting the two areas they were deficient in. Careful attention needs to be given to the T-35 and T-36 report to assure accurate reporting of expenses by each of the athletic teams as well as booster spending for each sport.

7. KHSAA Recommended Action in relation to new deficiencies

Note: Although the school was not given a deficiency there are still several areas of concern. The following actions are recommended to be taken by school officials.

- ✓ Submit to the KHSAA written minutes of the schools' Gender Equity Review Committee meetings for the 2008-2009 school year with the annual Title IX report.
- ✓ Submit to the KHSAA no later than **June 30, 2009**, the Travel Policy that is to be reviewed and revised by the Gender Equity Committee.
- ✓ Submit to the KHSAA no later than **June 30, 2009**, the results of a review of all varsity uniforms for quantity and quality the Gender Equity Committee. The school should also submit a copy of an adopted uniform replacement policy and schedule for all teams that participate in athletes at the school. A copy of this replacement and review process must be provided to all head coaches and must be placed in the school's Master Title IX File
- ✓ Submit to the KHSAA no later than **June 30, 2009**, a written policy for displaying banners, jerseys, pictures, trophies, banquets, honors, etc.
