Also, as stated in the 2001 report, a schedule for use of the weight room should be posted. A copy of that schedule is to be posted, as well as forwarded to the KHSAA no later than February 15, 2006.

Publicity	X		A continual problem is the media coverage for female sports. The KHSAA Audit Team believes the school has taken appropriate actions in trying to remedy this problem. A letter was sent to the media and was signed by the Principal and Athletic Director requesting additional coverage of female sports. The Athletic Director has also discussed the problem with the media personally. This has been an item and continues to be an item on the Corrective Action Plan. All actions to remedy this situation have been documented. The KHSAA Audit Team also requested the District Title IX Coordinator to recommend that the Superintendent also contact the media concerning this matter.

5. Brief Summary/Analysis of the Corrective Action Plan (Form T-60)

At the November 2005 visit there still was no schedule for weight room use posted at the facility. Warren Central must submit to the KHSAA, and post on their weight room facility, an established policy for its use by both genders.
