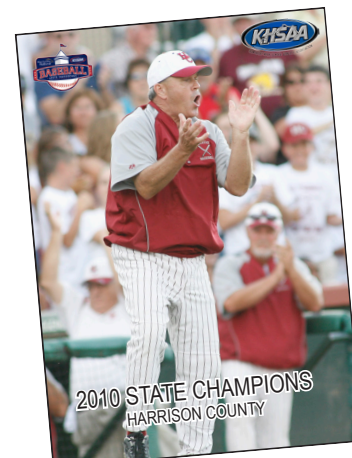
KHSAA WELCOMES KENTUCKY NATIONAL INSURANCE AS NEW TITLE SPONSOR

WHITAKER BANK PARK FIELD DIMENSIONS

Fence distances at Whitaker Bank Park are 318 feet down the left field line, 320 down the right field line and 401 to straight-away center field. Capacity for Whitake Bank Park for the State Baseball Tournament is 6,994.

HOME AND VISITING TEAMS

The team in the top bracket of the tournament draw will be the home team and use the first base dugout. The team in the bottom bracket of the draw will be the visiting team and use the third base dugout.

INCLEMENT WEATHER STATEMENT

Should it begin to rain, the games will continue on schedule unless there are signs of lightning or the umpires, in consultation with tournament management, determine that it is unsafe to continue.

In accordance with adopted KHSAA policy, if the games are suspended, the minimum suspension will be 30 minutes after the last sight of lightning or sound of thunder. When the decision is made to resume the game, there will be a 15-minute warm-up period will be given to both teams.
