### Coach's Comments

<b>Your team's accomplishment of advancing to the State Tournament:</b>
Montgomery pulled out a 53-49 victory over Mason County in the semi-finals of the region behind Sophomore Maggie Prewitt's 14 points and 5 rebounds. Tournament MVP Courtney Danis led the Lady Indians with 17 points in the 51-32 victory over Bishop Brossart in the final game.

### Coach's Comments

<b>What are keys (players/offensive/defensive) to your team's success in winning the tournament:</b>
Montgomery's top 4 offensive players must continue to produce: Jr. Courtney Danis 14.3 ppg, So. Maggie Prewitt 12.0 ppg, Fr. Mackenzie Lee 7.8 ppg, and Jr. Jenna High 7.7 ppg. Defensively the Lady Indians rely on several defenses to force an uptempo game. Maggie Prewitt leads the team in steals with 2.7 per game followed by Mackenzie Lee's 2.0 per game. Rebounding leaders Courtney Danis (6.3 rpg), Maggie Prewitt(4.8 rpg), and Natasha Thomas (3.9 rpg) must continue to work hard even though they are not as big as most players they've faced this season. Keys to winning the tournament: Montgomery must shoot the ball from the field much better and their pressure defense must produce offense. The depth on the bench provides another advantage for the Lady Indians.
