Coach's Comments

What are keys (players/offensive/defensive) to your team's success in winning the tournament:
Building a team that buys into the coach's philosophy -Tough Defense is the best Offense. #20 senior Chelsea Tolliver finally found that defense made her a complete player. She now owns more of the individual and career records than any previous player in Simon Kenton history. #33 senior Kayla Smith has learned to dominate in the paint under the basket by extending her 6'1" body with a long reach to block shots, rebound, and use the glass for put-backs. She is also a big threat in the high post area. #10 sophomore Sydni Wainscott is already a seasoned point guard, having run the team from that position for the past year. The coaching staff has complete confidence in the way she runs the offense. #21 junior Ali Ponzer is the darkhorse in the lineup. Forget about her, she can ring up the 3 pointers. And she is probably the fastest player ever to play Pioneer basketball. #25 senior Lyndsey Figgins found herself back in the regular starting line-up when her twin sister suffered a season ending knee injury in the semi-final regional game vrs Oldham County. Lyndsey is an excellent rebounder, defensive, and a very accurate shooter from the field. She lost two years as a starter on the team due to knee injuries. Finally the one aspect that makes the complete team is the fact that the 5 senior players are all ranked scholastically in the top 10 of their class, a statistic that is overlooked but a proud Pioneer stat.
