### **Competition Waters:**

### **Practice:**

- Competition waters are open for practice until 5:00 p.m. April 24.
- The purchasing of, or bartering for, information or the hiring of fishing guide services will not be permitted after April 9.

### **Boat Operation:**

- Contestants are not permitted to drive the boat when the combustion engine is in operation. Each boat will be driven by a coach or volunteer driver. Contestants may operate the trolling motor. Coaches and volunteers may provide assistance, including information about locating and catching fish, but are not permitted to fish.

### **Catch & Size Limit:**

- Five bass per team, minimum 12-inches on spotted bass and 15-inches on largemouth and smallmouth bass.

### **License Requirement:**
