DELEGATE PROPOSALS

SWEET 16® TOURNAMENT DRAWS

Due to a scheduling conflict, the date of the draw for the both the 2001 KHSAA Boys' & Girls' Sweet 16® State Basketball Tournaments has been changed.

Originally scheduled for Fri., Jan. 26, the draw has been moved to Fri., Feb. 2. Again, WKYT-TV in Lexington will air the draw of both tournaments live as a part of its *After Noon* news program at 12:30 p.m. (ET). WKYT-TV will again make the program available free via satellite to any station in the state.

Complete tournament brackets will be posted on the KHSAA website at the conclusion of the program.

The Boys' State Tournament is scheduled for March 14-17, at Rupp Arena in Lexington. The Girls' State Tournament is scheduled for March 21-24 at Western Kentucky University's E.A. Diddle Arena in Bowling Green.

TITLE IX MAILING TO SCHOOLS

The KHSAA recently mailed the following forms to all member schools. These forms are to be submitted for the 2000-2001 school year not later than April 15, 2001.

1. Form GE-19 (KHSAA Annual Verification of Title IX Procedures)
2. Forms T-1 through T-4 (Summary Forms for Determining Student Interests and Abilities)
3. Form T-41 (Checklist for the Overall Interscholastic Athletics Program)
4. Form T-60 (Updated Corrective Action Plan)
5. Form T-63 (Summary of the Interscholastic Student Interest Survey)

NOTE: Single-sex schools are not required to submit the forms.

CORRESPONDING DATES REMINDER

It is imperative that Principals, Athletic Directors and Coaches review the corresponding dates section of the Handbook (pages 108 and 109) as you schedule for 2001-02, and especially, 2002-03. School year 2002-03 is the year when the calendar "rolls over" as it does every few years in order to account for the proper numbering of weeks. This is invaluable when you are reviewing your 2001 and 2002 football contracts.

SOFTBALL SCHOOLS

Rather than send a questionnaire, schools are notified through this edition of the Commissioner's Notes that you are to inform the KHSAA as to your intent to play slow pitch softball, fast pitch softball or both for the coming 2001 season.

Schools should notify the KHSAA (Attention Asst. Commissioner Larry Boucher) by FAX (859-293-5999) their intention to play slow pitch softball only or both slow and fast pitch.

It will be assumed that if a school played fast pitch during the 2000 season they will be playing fast pitch again during the upcoming 2001 season. If a school did not play fast pitch last season (2000), and intends to play fast pitch in the 2001 season, the school should also make notification to the KHSAA of this intent. The KHSAA should be notified of member school's softball team(s) intentions no later than January 15, 2001.

BASKETBALL SCORE REPORTING / STATS

This is a reminder to boys' and girls' basketball coaches and member school Athletic Directors regarding reporting of scores of basketball games and stats.

A mailing was sent directly to head coaches the first week of December, reminding you to call in the scores of your games, home or away, win or lose, to the KHSAA Scoreboard 1-888-366-8706. It is import to do this IMMEDIATELY following each game as numerous media outlets from across the state use this service when reporting or publishing scores. Should a game be canceled or rescheduled, you should still report the information to the number.

In addition, we continue to have some schools that have not checked their basketball schedules to verify correct dates/times/opponents. The Association went from printing a master schedule book to the on-line listing as a means of providing a more "up to date" schedule.

Basketball statistics reporting will begin Thurs., Jan. 11, as was mentioned in the correspondence to head coaches. Stats will only be accepted on-line through the KHSAA website. This is the same manner in which schools reported football stats. Rankings will be posted on the KHSAA website after 4 p.m. (ET) each Thursday throughout the remainder of the season.

BASKETBALL TEAM PICTURES

This is a reminder that boys' and girls' basketball team pictures are due, as printed in the 2000-2001 KHSAA memo calendar, to the Association by Fri., Feb. 2, 2001. Photos should include an identification.

Again, xeroxed copies of pictures or tear-sheets from your game programs are not acceptable. Scanned pictures are acceptable, but must be at 300 dpi and saved with a file extension of .gif, .tif, or .jpg.

KHSAA OFFICE HOLIDAY SCHEDULE
