NOTE: Single-sex schools are not required to submit the forms.

Boys' tickets are scheduled to be mailed out around Feb. 15 and girls' tickets around Feb. 22. The last day to order tickets through the KHSAA by phone (859)299-5472 or the internet (www.khsaa.org) is Fri., Feb. 23. After that date, ticket sales move to the host venue box office.

SCHOLAR ATHLETE OF THE GAME

This is a recognition program that is promoted over the network with the honorees receiving a certificate following the tournaments. The program is not limited to basketball players and each school may nominate as many athletes in any sport.

IMPORTANT REMINDER ON BASKETBALL CORRESPONDING DATES

Through the 2007 State Tournament in basketball, the first week of district play will be in week 35 according to the corresponding date chart on page 109 of the KHSAA Handbook. Since all basketball games start on the Monday after Thanksgiving (which is the Monday of week 22 on the same chart), there is a natural rollover during the 2002-03 playing season. Due to natural "rollovers" in corresponding dates, persons scheduling games should be certain to check the chart on page 109 for the proper contracted date. In essence, contracts which call for a date in 2001-02 and for which it is desired to play the game on the same date in 2002-03 should have 6 days added to the 2001-02 date. For example, a game scheduled on December 10, 2001 should be scheduled on December 16, 2002 for proper corresponding.

Teams in seeded districts are also reminded that ALL games involved in the seeding records MUST be played prior to the Sunday two weeks before the district.

Log on to the KHSAA Website and Check Your School Information. You will need to use your previously-issued password. It is imperative that you continually update your information as any changes occur to information as printed in the Handbook. This will help us make sure correspondence is properly addressed.

THREE-PERSON OFFICIATING

The KHSAA again reminds member schools that there is no requirement or mandate to use three officials at any time for basketball games during the regular season. However, three officials will be used in boys' and girls' district, regional and state tournament competitions.

In addition, in accordance with the KHSAA Handbook, the district game fee for each of three officials is \$40 per game. Regional tournament officiating fees are \$45 per official. Twenty cents per round trip mile is allowed for one car per game with no hook-up mileage allowed. Assigning secretaries (and not game officials) will be providing tournament managers with specific game fee/mileage fee information for tournament assigned officials.

LOCKERS NEEDED

Many schools are in the process of updating lockers, whether they are gym lockers or class lockers.
