SELECTION OF EXTRACURRICULAR PROGRAMS POLICY



Topic	Statement
A. Criteria for Programs	<p>For an extracurricular program to be continued or to institute a new program, the program must:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Contribute to the following Kentucky Learning Goals: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> a. Becoming a self-sufficient individual. b. Becoming responsible members of a family, work group, or community, including demonstrating effectiveness in community service. 2. Generate and maintain student interest as well as attract students currently not involved in

	<p>extracurricular or service projects.</p> <p>3. Encourage, enhance, and maintain equity including but not limited to a wide range of opportunities for both male and female students.</p> <p>4. Have a suitable adult sponsor and have appropriate adult supervision at all times.</p>
B. Definition of Extracurricular Activities	<p>Extracurricular activities shall be defined as any activity, which does not have a direct connection to a curricular class in which a student is being awarded a grade. The student is considered to be representing Henry County High School while participating in these activities and is under applicable school rules and procedures.</p>
C. Coach/Sponsor	<p>1. An adult coach or sponsor who meets the criteria established by any applicable sponsoring organization will lead each extracurricular activity.</p> <p>2. The coach or sponsor will be responsible for supervising all students while they are participating in the activity, including preparation and travel time.</p> <p>3. The principal will assign coaches and sponsors from our school's current staff following SBDM policy on assignments of staff time. If it is necessary to consider applicants who do not currently work at our school, our policy on consultation on vacancies will be followed.</p> <p>4. The coach or sponsor is required to adhere to all accounting procedures outlined by the district.</p>
D. Academic Requirements	<p>1. Grades will be checked weekly on Friday to determine eligibility. If school is not in session on Friday, grades will be checked on the next day school is in session.</p> <p>2. A student shall be deemed ineligible based on KHSAA regulation.</p>
E. Attendance Requirements	<p>1. Students must be credited with a half day of attendance on the day of any extracurricular activity in order to participate in that particular event.</p> <p>2. Participation eligibility may be affected by extenuating circumstances that do not permit a half day of attendance such as: funerals, doctor visits,</p>

	<p>hospital visits, or other excused absences, as determined by the school administration.</p> <p>3. Extenuating circumstances must be communicated to the principal the day prior to the extracurricular event.</p>
F. Students Who Quit a Sport during the Season	A student who quits a sport during the season and that team has completed 10% of that team's varsity schedule may not join the next sport until the one he/she quit has completed their season.
G. Abuse of coaches and administrators at games and practices.	If a parent/guardian or fan publically accosts a coach/administrator at or after a game or practice, that parent/guardian or fan will not be permitted to attend extracurricular activities at Henry County High School for the remainder of the school year.
H. Note	This policy does not rule out additional participation requirements of each extracurricular activity as defined and articulated by a coach; it only addresses academic achievement and school attendance requirements.
