PLAYERS RESPONSIBILITIES

1. Refer to your practice schedule, you will be where you are supposed to be and you will always be on time.
2. If you find a reason to request absence from scheduled practice or team meeting due to academic work or illness, you must notify a member of the coaching staff, prior to absence. Unexcused absences will not, for any reason, be tolerated. A reminder: those who come to practice are those who will be eligible to play.
3. Appearance: never underestimate the importance of you appearance, you appearance reflects the impression others will have of our team. Cleanliness of body and neatness in dress is expected at all times.
4. **ABSOLUTELY NO USE OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES!!!!!!!!!!**
5. **ABSOLUTELY NO USE OF DRUGS OR TOBACCO PRODUCTS!!!!!!**
6. You must maintain good academic standing to remain eligible. Always remember that you are a student first and foremost and an athlete second. Pay attention in class, work hard, and establish good study habits and each one of you should be fine. If you are experiencing difficulties, let someone on the coaching staff know and we will try to make arrangements to help you.
7. We encourage each of you to eat three meals per day, especially breakfast. Breakfast is the most important meal of the day. This is even more important the day of a game.
8. Stay out of places and groups of questionable respectability. Always use good judgment in all you do.
9. Respect your coaches, facilities, teachers, classmates, opponents, teammates, and yourself at all times.
10. Be a gentleman at all times.

11. Each of you is expected to set the proper example on school grounds by supporting our school's programs and rules. This involves:
 - A. Following all school rules and practices.
 - B. Do not expect special privilege because you are an athlete.
 - C. We encourage you to join other extracurricular activities, if you so desire. We want you to enjoy and receive the benefits of the total school experience.
 - D. Showing leadership and willingness to help others.
 - E. Not being disruptive in your classes, be as cooperative as you can.
12. Bus conduct is very important, when on the bus follow bus rules and act like a gentleman. No rough housing will be tolerated.
13. Fairness does not always mean equality. You will be treated accordingly, to what you earn and deserve, as determined by the coaching staff. You will always be respected as a unique individual, treated fairly, and with the utmost dignity. No one will be treated special for any reason.
