



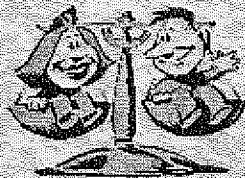

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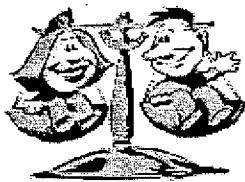

- 2) Add the total number of girls and boys enrolled to determine total enrollment, (place in Row 3, Column 1).
- 3) Calculate the percentage of total enrollment that is female. (Divide Row 1, Column 1 by Row 3, Column 1 and place in Row 1, Column 2.) Calculate the percentage of total enrollment that is male. SBDM – February 4, 2003

Mr. White called the meeting to order. Those in attendance were: Mary Stevens, Jimbo Lyttle, Judge O.G. House, Linda Cornett, JoAnne Gregory, Steve Mobley and Mr. White.

The minutes from the December meeting were read and corrections made. The January meeting had to be cancelled due to inclement weather. The agenda for the meeting was read and approved.

There was discussion regarding Clay County High School Policy Number XII and XIII. Mr. White discussed some specifics and concerns regarding Policy XIII. The consensus was to approve Policy XII which is Consultation on Vacancy. There will be further discussion about Policy XIII at the March meeting.

The next item on the agenda was Cheerleader Rules and Regulations. These were distributed at the December meeting and SBDM members were asked to read them and be prepared to discuss any concerns. The consensus was to approve the Cheerleader Rules and Regulations.

Mrs. Linda Cornett presented the proposed Youth Service Center budget for next year to the SBDM for approval (Attachment A). There was some discussion about how beneficial the YSC and Mrs. Mary Nicholson are to Clay County High School. Mr. White said, "Mrs. Nicholson and the Youth Service Center provides our school with things we probably couldn't afford otherwise." The consensus was to approve the budget.

Mr. White gave those in attendance a copy of the Athletic Gender Equity Committee Policy proposals (Attachment B). During the athletic audit conducted by the KHSAA there were two areas of concern regarding Title IX – Gender Equity: uniform purchase/replacement and cost of meals when traveling. The policies address these concerns.

In the area of good news, Mr. White first mentioned the Curriculum Committee meeting that was held Monday after school. He was impressed with the number of faculty members who stayed for the meeting and was very optimistic about the many topics discussed at the meeting. He would like for the teachers to know what they will be teaching in the fall before they leave for summer vacation. Everyone was encouraged to speak up with thoughts, concerns, and problems. Some of the things discussed were: ESS/Summer School, 7 period day, length of class periods, quality of lab if periods were shorter. Mr. White said, "We have many things to consider. It was a very good meeting." The Curriculum Committee will meet with every department in the school.

For new business, Mr. White announced that the CATS testing window will be May 6 – May 15. Mary Stevens shared teachers' concerns regarding the new substitute process as it is now. There have been numerous problems getting substitutes. Mr. White concurred and counted seven days when there hasn't been enough to cover our absent teachers. The whole situation is bad.

Linda Cornett discussed the budget situation (Attachments C, D, and E). She said that we have about \$8,000. left for textbooks. Everyone's computer is up to date. We have about \$60,000 to spend. We have asked to be a Title I school which is determined by the number of economically disadvantaged students we have enrolled. We have always qualified but have never received the money. We cannot apply for any "No Child Left Behind" grants if

we are not a Title I school. To get Title I funds the SBDM must come up with what we need, why we need it, how it will be used, and the anticipated cost. We may possibly get a reading teacher next year.

Mr. White said, "The teachers have sacrificed for us to have money at this point in the school year. We need to figure out what we may be short on next year and buy it now." We will look at the projected budget for next year as well as Section 7 allocations at the next meeting. Mr. White told everyone that he should have curriculum news at the next meeting.

The meeting was adjourned.
