Since 39% of the participation is female a close eye needs to be given to assure that football spending does not turn this into a red flag issue, currently who are spending \$499 per male athlete compared to \$408 per female athlete and this puts East Ridge very close to non-compliance in this area. (1) Concern and possible red flag issue the \$1,414 more for Boys Basketball compared to Girls Basketbal. (2) Concern and very much a red flag concern is zero dollars spent on travel in Boys Baseball (3) Concern with awards expenditures in only three sports. (Line Blank) Survey indicates interest in these sports that East Ridge does not offer: Girls and Boys Soccer, Girls and Boys Swimming, Boys Wresting, Girls and Boys Tennis. Gender Equity Committee needs to meet and put together a plan to determine if these interests are real and if so to provide corrective action plans to address these interests.
