X	Other Recommendation and Comments: It was recommended on the schools' 2004-2005 Annual Report, that students are to be members of the Gender Equity Committee, however on the schools' 2005-2006 Annual Report it appears that students are still not participants on the Gender Equity Committee. At least no students' name was identified on the report as being a member. The KHSAA has clearly defined the make-up of the committee. The school is strongly urged to add students to the Gender Equity Committee and that meetings be held when students can attend and be active participants. The school needs to examine why female participation is so low; out of a student body of 552; only 234 are female it appears that there would more than 31 females participating in the athletic program at Shawnee. The committee should actively examine this matter to increase female participation. The method by which students are surveyed should also be examined and discussed, the percentage of returned results was 29%. There is not enough sufficient response from the student body.
