- 1) Determine the total number of girls enrolled, (place in Row 1, Column 1). Determine the total number of boys enrolled, (place in Row 2, Column 1).
- 2) Add the total number of girls and boys enrolled to determine total enrollment, (place in Row 3, Column 1).
- 3) Calculate the percentage of total enrollment that is female. (Divide Row 1, Column 1 by Row 3, Column 1 and place in Row 1, Column 2.) Calculate the percentage of total enrollment that is male. (Divide Row 2, Column 1 by Row 3, Column 1 and place in Row 2, Column 2.) Note: Row 1, Column 2 plus Row 2, Column 2 should total 100%.
- Ask the head coaches to review the most updated eligibility or squad lists for their teams. Ask coaches to confirm the names of those individuals who are on the team as of the first date of regular season competition, and cross out the names of those who were cut from the team or quit the team prior to the first regular season competitive event. Calculate the percentage of male participation. (Row 2, Column 3 divided by Row 3, Column 3 and place in Row 2, Column 4.) Note: Row 1, Column 4 plus Row 2, Column 4 should total 100%.

Note: While being within three percent is <u>not</u> a formal compliance standard; if the percent listed in Row 1, Column 4 is within 3% of Row 1, Column 2, then it provides a good target within which compliance is likely.

I WOULD LIKE TO INFORM THE KHSAA THAT I PUT THE WRONG INFORMATION IN THE WRONG COLUMN. THE INFORMATION I PUT FOR AWARDS SHOULD HAVE BEEN IN THE COACHES SALARIES COLUMN. BY RESUBMITTING THE INFORMATION REQUESTED, I HOPE AS ATHLETIC DIRECTOR I HAVE ANSWERED YOUR QUESTION CONCERNING THIS ISSUE. MYSELF, AND MR. PHIL BARTLEY, THE PRINCIPAL OF MONROE CO. HIGH SCHOOL HAVE BEEN IN THE PROCESS OF CHANGING OUR AWARDS POLICY. WE ACKNOWLEDGE HOW THIS MAY LOOK CONCERNING OUR OTHER PROGRAMS SUCH AS, TENNIS, TRACK. AND VOLLEYBALL.

WE ARE NOW IN THE PROCESS OF AN AWARDS POLICY FOR THE 2008-09 SCHOOL YEAR. TO RECTIFY THIS PROBLEM, MONROE CO. HIGH SCHOOL WILL PUT IN PLACE A POLICY FOR RECOGNIZING OUR STUDENT ATHLETES, IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE KHSAA POLICY CONCERNING THIS ISSUE.

EACH HEAD COACH, ALONG WITH THE ATHLETIC DIRECTOR WILL PUT IN PLACE CERTAIN AWARDS TO BE GIVEN THAT IS IN APPLAINCE TO KHSAA RULES. THE HEAD COACH WILL SUBMITT THE AWARDS THAT WILL BE GIVEN TO THE ATHLETIC DIRECTOR AND THE ATHLETIC DIRECTOR AND THE ATHLETIC DIRECTOR APPROVAL.

STARTING IN 2008-09 SCHOOL YEAR, MONROE CO. HIGH SCHOOL WILL HOLD THREE SANCTIONED ATHLETIC AWARD BANQUETS. THE SPRING PROGRAM WILL CONSIST OF: TRACK, BASEBALL, SOFTBALL, AND TENNIS.

IN CLOSING, I KNOW THIS WILL STRENGTHEN AND MAKE EACH OF OUR PROGRAMS MORE EQUAL AND VISIBLE WHEN WE HAVE OUR ATHLETIC AWARDS BANQUETS. BY DOING THIS I HOPE THIS WILL INVOLVE MORE OF OUR PARENTS IN PARTICIPATING IN THE PROCESS OF JOINING TOGETHER WITH OTHER SPORTS PROGRAMS PARENTS IN RECOGNIZING OUR STUDENT ATHLETES.

AS ATHLETIC DIRECTOR OF MONROE CO. HIGH SCHOOL, ALONG WITH THE PRINCIPAL, MR. PHIL BARTLEY, WE WILL SEE THAT WE ARE IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE STATUES OF THE KHSAA CONCERNING RULES AND REGULATIONS OF AWARDS GIVEN.
