Dear Mr. Hamilton:

For the past four years your school has consistently spent more money on male athletes than female athletes. This is certainly a red flag in respect to equity in benefits provided to your athletes. This issue has been addressed in previous reviews of your annual reports. Auditors also addressed this issue during your revisit audit that was conducted this past year. Unfortunately, your school has not made this a priority on your Corrective Action Plan, but yet this disparity in spending continues to be a reoccurring problem.

Since you report expenditures for the prior year, I am requesting that those be available for your schools first Title IX meeting in the fall. At that meeting your committee should review the expenditures and determine whether you still have an inequity in spending. If an inequity exists, your committee should then develop a plan to address this problem. The minutes of that meeting should be submitted to the KHSAA as well as the plan that is developed to address this problem by October, 2008. Please advise if I can assist you with this process in anyway.

- 1) Determine the total number of girls enrolled, (place in Row 1, Column 1). Determine the total number of boys enrolled, (place in Row 2, Column 1).
- 2) Add the total number of girls and boys enrolled to determine total enrollment, (place in Row 3, Column 1).
- 3) Calculate the percentage of total enrollment that is female. (Divide Row 1, Column 1 by Row 3, Column 1 and place in Row 1, Column 2.) Calculate the percentage of total enrollment that is male. (Divide Row 2, Column 1 by Row 3, Column 1 and place in Row 2, Column 2.) Note: Row 1, Column 2 plus Row 2, Column 2 should total 100%.
- 4) Ask the head coaches to review the most updated eligibility or squad lists for their teams.
