D.	X	According to the 2007-2008 data, the school appears to be meeting the standards established in Test 1 (Athletic participation is proportionate to enrollment) Test 2 (History and continuing practice of program expansion) Test 3 (Full and effective accommodation of interests and abilities)
E.	X	Other Recommendation and Comments According to calculations submitted, the school is currently meeting the standard established in Test 1 for the provision of athletic opportunities. Responses given on the T-3 form also indicate that the school is meeting the standard established in Test 3. The results of the most recent student survey do not support the school's responses on T-3 (i.e. 56 girls indicated an interest in soccer and 58 girls indicated an interest in tennis). On future submittals, the school should respond on T-3 forms based on the most recent student survey and/or their efforts to address interests indicated on that survey. In the area of benefits, athletic spending is slightly outside acceptable parameters (i.e. approximately \$470 per male athlete compared to \$346 per female athlete). This spending should be closely monitored to insure that an imbalance does not continue over a two-year period.
