

- 2) Add the total number of girls and boys enrolled to determine total enrollment, (place in Row 3, Column 1).
- Calculate the percentage of total enrollment that is female. (Divide Row 1, Column 1 by Row 3, Column 1 and place in Row 1, Column 2.) Calculate the percentage of total enrollment that is male. 

 - Divide Column 2, Row 2 by Column 2, Row 4, and place the percentage in Column 3, Row 2.
 - Divide Column 2, Row 3 by Column 2, Row 4, and place the percentage in Column 3, Row 3.

For boys' varsity, junior varsity, and frosh, respectively:

- Divide Column 2, Row 5 by Column 2, Row 8, and place the percentage in Column 3, Row 5.
- Divide Column 2, Row 6 by Column 2, Row 8, and place the percentage in Column 3, Row 6.
- Divide Column 2, Row 7 by Column 2, Row 8, and place the percentage in Column 3, Row 7.
