Other Recommendation and Comments: For the second consecutive year Frankfort High School does not appear to be in compliance by passing one of the three tests (T-1, T-2 or T-3), Attempts have been very, very slow in coming into compliance on T-3. For the past five years the T-41 forms indicate that the Boys Programs have an advantage in Accommodation of Interest and Abilities. 	Each year the schools Corrective Action Plan reflect that something is going to be done and dates are given and changed each year as to when this sport will become a reality for the young ladies at Frankfort High School. For nine years the school has put off starting the sport for various reasons. The school was requested to send the 2009-2010 Gender Equity Committee Meeting Minutes to the KHSAA to document that the school was discussing and setting forth Corrective Action to finally settle an issued that may well be a MAJOR RED FLAG issue for Frankfort High School. By October 1, 2010 the school needs to forward to the KHSAA the minutes of the Gender Equity Committee for 2009 and 2010 and all minutes of
	future Gender Equity Committee minutes are to be sent with the Annual Report
	each year.
	According to the information given in the Annual Report there are no Male Student Athletes represented on the Gender Equity Committee. It is highly recommended that both a male and female student athlete be represented on this committee.
,	At the Title IX revisit in the fall of 2009 the issues of not reporting Travel Expenditures for each sport was a potential Red Flag. After some discussion with the Assistant Superintendent he informed the Audit Team that these figures could be obtained and that the 2009-2010 Annual Report would indeed reflect actual Travel Expenditures for all sports. This was not done and means that the T-35 and T-36 forms that had to be re-submitted are still incomplete.
	The differences in coaching salaries in like sports are still an issue that could be a
	potential Red Flag that Frankfort High School may have to address.
	The overall expenditures for Boys and Girls Athletics appear to be ok but there is an
	inaccurate reporting of travel expenditures and there is no way to determine at this
	time if a problem exists.

Title IX Review Committee:

I have included a copy of a report in an attempt to explain some of the information included with Frankfort High School's Title IX document.

As in the past, the big accommodation of interest for our students has been the interest of volleyball for our female student athletes. During our student interest survey this again came up. We are going to continue to pursue this option, but the Frankfort Administration is concerned that if we were to add volleyball that we would in turn deplete our girl's soccer program. We had on the roster last year only 18 girls for soccer and if we are to take just a few that puts our soccer program in jeopardy. We are going to have another student meeting after school hours to gauge the real interest in the volleyball situation. Our other concern with the addition of volleyball is space and facilities. We only have 2 gyms (high school and elementary school gymnasiums), with which neither is equipped to for volleyball. We could look at the modification of the gym floor at the high school, but our district is a small district that is tight on funds.

You will also notice that our males outnumber our females in participating buy a large number while the enrollment is virtually equal. There is really no explanation as to why, we are looking to add another female sport coach in the building and hopefully this will help in the recruitment of more girls for our sports.

Transportation at Frankfort is covered by the board for any athletic COMPETITION, the only time a sport is charged transportation is for a practice or for trips.

We are excited that we have increased our participation on the female side and will continue to do that by looking at the addition of volleyball and continuing to recruit our females from the building to participate in the sports that we have offered.

- 2) Add the total number of girls and boys enrolled to determine total enrollment, (place in Row 3, Column 1).
- Calculate the percentage of total enrollment that is female. (Divide Row 1, Column 1 by Row 3, Column 1 and place in Row 1, Column 2.) Calculate the percentage of total enrollment that is male. (Divide Row 2, Column 1 by Row 3, Column 1 and place in Row 2, Column 2.) Note: Row 1, Column 2 plus Row 2, Column 2 should total 100%.
 - Ask coaches to confirm the names of those individuals who are on the team as of the first date of regular season competition, and cross out the names of those who were cut from the team or quit the team prior to the first regular season competitive event. Remember, test three – full accommodation means addressing the unmet interest of the underrepresented sex (most likely girls), not the overrepresented sex (most likely boys).

Plans to Address Interest:

We will have another student lead interest meeting during school hours and then one after school hours during what would be a practice time for volleyball. Depending on the interest at the after school meeting we will meet with administration and proceed from there.


