Interest in girl's golf and/or soccer should continue to be pursued in order to determine its validity and to insure future compliance in this area. In the area of benefits, total athletic spending meets the acceptable parameters both on a percentage and a per athlete basis. With the exception of football, no other sports show expenditures for awards. To insure equity, the school's awards guideline should be reviewed that qualifies recognition for all sports participants. This information should be

reflected on future Corrective Action Plans and Gender Equity Committee minutes. In
order to benefit all students, it is recommended that a female student athlete also be a
representative on the Gender Equity Committee.
