E.		<ul> <li>Other Recommendation and Comments:</li> <li>The Gender Equity Committee needs to take a close look at the T-2 test and make sure that all the figures are being reported accurately. At this time it appears that Iroquois is passing Test 2.</li> <li>The required Student Interest Survey for 2009-2010 was not sent with that Annual Report. The KHSAA instructed the Gender Equity Committee to meet in August or September 2010 and put forth plans to conduct a Student Interest Survey and send the results to the KHSAA by October 1. Since this was not sent in we have to assume that the survey was never administered and a notation to that will be placed in the school permanent Title IX file at the KHSAA. (It is pointed out that another survey will be required during the 2011-</li> </ul>

2012 school year.

- For the second year in a row it is pointed out that a male student athlete in not represented on the Gender Equity Committee. Title IX highly recommends that BOTH a male and female student athlete be represented on the Gender Equity Committee.
- A potential RED FLAG area is developing when we look at the T-35 and T-36 forms. The Gender Equity Committee needs take a very close look at the spending differences in boys and girls athletics.
- With the figures turned in with this report the school spent \$540.34 per male athlete compared to \$439.93 per female athlete for a difference in spending of \$130.41 per athlete. When you are a football playing school we know that the spending between boys and girls will never be equal, however when this difference in spending is over \$100.00 you are potentially in a RED FLAG area.
- The difference in coaching salaries will continue to be a potential red flag area for Iroquois and the Gender Equity Committee needs to document yearly how this salary structure is sit up and keeps put this information in the minutes of the committee.
- The Gender Equity Committee needs to address the issues of the ZERO expenditure's for travel in Baseball, Cross Country, Golf and Tennis. In today's world nobody travels for free.
- All minutes of the Gender Equity Committee are to be sent to the KHSAA with the Annual Report and this was not done with the 2010-2011 Annual Report.

\*Number of 8<sup>th</sup> grade students & below used in Column 3 and Column 4 calculations: 0

- 1) Determine the total number of girls enrolled, (place in Row 1, Column 1). Determine the total number of boys enrolled, (place in Row 2, Column 1).
- 2) Add the total number of girls and boys enrolled to determine total enrollment, (place in Row 3, Column 1).
- 3) Calculate the percentage of total enrollment that is female. (Divide Row 1, Column 1 by Row 3, Column 1 and place in Row 1, Column 2.) Calculate the percentage of total enrollment that is male. (Divide Row 2, Column 1 by Row 3, Column 1 and place in Row 2, Column 2.) Note: Row 1, Column 2 plus Row 2, Column 2 should total 100%.
- Ask coaches to confirm the names of those individuals who are on the team as of the first **date of regular season competition**, and cross out the names of those who were cut from the team or quit the team prior to the first regular season competitive event. Determine the total number of interscholastic athletics participants that are girls, (and place in Row 1, Column 3). In order to determine the total number of athletics participants, an individual should be counted each time he or she participates on a team. For example, if Jane Doe competes on the varsity volleyball team, the junior varsity volleyball team, and the varsity softball team, she should be counted as four participants (**do not include club or intramural sports participants, cheerleaders, dance teams, or pom squads**). Calculate the same way for boys and girls. \* In addition, should 8<sup>th</sup> grade students and below play on a Freshman, Junior Varsity, or Varsity team, they should also be counted for each team and sport on which they participate. Using the same procedure, determine the total number of interscholastic athletic participants that are boys, (and place in Row 2, Column 3). Add Row 1, Column 3 plus Row 2, Column 3 to get total participants and place in Row 3, Column 3.

Calculate the percentage of female participation. (Row 1, Column 3 divided by Row 3, Column 3 and place in Row 1, Column 4.)
Calculate the percentage of male participation. (Row 2, Column 3 divided by Row 3, Column 3 and place in Row 2, Column 4.) Note: Row 1, Column 4 plus Row 2, Column 4 should total 100%.

Note: While being within three percent is <u>not</u> a formal compliance standard, if the percent listed in Row 1, Column 4 is within 3% of Row 1, Column 2, then it provides a good target within which compliance is likely.

- 1) For Column 1, list the number of interscholastic teams offered for girls and boys at each competitive level (varsity, junior varsity, and freshman). For girls, total each of the entries in Rows 1, 2, and 3 into Row 4. For boys, total Rows 5, 6, and 7 into Row 8.
- 2) For Column 2, list the number of participants at each level. For girls, total each of the entries in Rows 1, 2, and 3 into Row 4. For boys, total Rows 5, 6, and 7 into Row 8. Note: The totals in Row 4 for girls and in Row 8 for boys must be the same as the totals in Form T-1, Column 3, Rows 1 and 2 respectively.
