Explanation/ Description of Awards expenditures

The sports of boys' track, boys' golf and swimming and diving did not hold end of season banquets or provide awards to their participants. Type of award recognition ceremonies, locations of these ceremonies, and amounts to be spent on the ceremonies and awards themselves (including end-of-season recognitions) are left to the discretion of the individual teams. With that said, our boys' track program has been almost non-existent and has not performed to the level of success we expect at Lafayette. Additionally, we have since had a change in head coaches in boys' golf, swimming and diving, and will be hiring a new boys' track coach at the end of this school year. With new leadership in place, we have expressed to them the need to provide awards, and other recognitions that, in turn, promote participation and a sense of accomplishment.
