When considering the results of the survey and comparing them to the current level $f$ participation, it is clear to see there is a viable interest in the sports listed above. We have 28 teams with a school enrollment near 450. The particpatgion level on test 1 indicates we are already $10 \%$ higher in male participation. Adding another male sport would make the difference even greater. The exploration of adding archery for girls is one that would have to come with the consequence of having to drop a sport already in place. This is reflected in sports such as tennis and soccer. In considering the warranted needs of our students it will be something that we have to look at in the future. We will monitor plans, look at the population surveyed, and to find out what other teams would suffer if we did add another team.
