During our last KHSAA Student Interest Survey (2011), 38 boys and 40 girls expressed an interest in participation in bowling. In the Fall of the 2013-2014 school year, we will conduct another Student Interest Survey to gauge student interest in sports not currently offered. If the Gender Equity Committee agrees that there appears to be sufficient student interest in a bowling team, interest meetings will be conducted with students and parents, and an attempt to find a school sponsor will take place during the 2013-2014 school year. The school will also do a study of schools in our geographic region, who participate in the sport of bowling, but who also has to travel out-of-county for a bowling facility. The GEC would then determine if the sport of bowling is cost efficient for our current school athletic budget.
