- 3) Calculate the percentage of total enrollment that is female. (Divide Row 1, Column 1 by Row 3, Column 1 and place in Row 1, Column 2.) Calculate the percentage of total enrollment that is male. - 4) Ask coaches to confirm the names of those individuals who are on the team as of the first **date of regular season competition**, and cross out the names of those who were cut from the team or quit the team prior to the first regular season competitive event.
