Along with this T65 form, you have also received a copy of a revised Title IX Internal Audit Summary for this school. It is important that you review all of the details concerning the analysis of the report submitted.

The Internal Audit Summary will analyze all parts of the three-part test for Title IX compliance, based on a snapshot of the data on the date submitted. Those conclusions are listed. Revisions have been made in this form to clarify the calculation of the underrepresented gender and ensure the preservation of the integrity of the foundational purposes of Title IX. The form also continues to contain notes made to help you determine how calculations were derived and detail the exclusion of certain elements related to Archery and Bass Fishing which are true coed sport-activities.

In the first section you will note many factors such as per total participation, total expenditures, participant spending (per gender), and many other factors to be considered as you move forward with future planning. You will also note on Row 13, the determination of the underrepresented gender in your school. This is a critical element in determining Title IX compliance.

The Test 1 (traditionally called the “numbers” test) section again contains guidance as to the number of new participants in the underrepresented gender needed to meet this test. Explanatory notes in the right column should help verify the calculations, which were done by the system based on the submitted data.

The Test 2 (traditionally called the “recent history of expanding sport offerings for the underrepresented gender” test) section contains the information for Test 2 and the calculations were done solely by the system based on the submitted data.

The Test 3 (traditionally called the “accommodating interest and abilities” test) section contains the information for Test 3. This is determined by the audit team based on the analysis of the data provided.

At the bottom of the Title IX Internal Audit Summary is a summary conclusion as to whether or not the school appears to be in compliance with one of the three parts of the tests for Title IX compliance. But, we had a sign up sheet for both boys and girls tennis in September of this school year, and only 8 boys and 7 girls signed up. Because it takes at least 7 players to field a full team, administration decided to table further investigation of tennis until this year's survey was completed. Upon completion of this survey, we will again place sign up sheets in the front office, and the AD will conduct an informational meeting before the school year ends to better gauge the interest of underclass students.</p> <p>It should be noted however, that while tennis did garner interest in this survey, the other two sports that received the most interest were in fact sports we already offer. 12 Respondents listed track and field as a sport they would like to play and 8 respondents listed volleyball. Those responses cause some pause in considering the survey results.</p> <p>Still, we will look at tennis again before school ends and the AD will monitor closely how serious the interest is.</p> <p>The latest survey did show that the students responding had almost no interest in Archery, which was a sport we had begun to investigate last school year.</p>

The development of our athletic complex will remove this expense from our annual football budget. In fact if you remove football spending, our school spending in the submitted T35 report is actually more for our girls programs than our boys programs. In 16-17, our school spending on boys programs other than football was \$35,807, while the school spending on girls programs was \$37,693. Administration believes these numbers show our continued focus on equal spending. It should also be noted that the booster spending in the T35 report is actually each team's individual fundraising account spending. All of our team's have their own fundraising goals and some teams annually spend more than others. For instance, in 16-17 our boys basketball booster spending on travel ws \$1,872 and the girls was \$27. This is because the boys team chose to travel out of town for a Christmas tournament and the girls team chose to play in a local tournament. All of the boy's spending during this tournament was taken from their own fundraising, none was provided by a school booster organization. Additionally, in the same report the baseball team spent \$9,975 in booster money on equipment, while the softball team spent only \$822. This is because the baseball team raised it's own funds to purchase a Gator for field maintenance, something the softball program purchased several years ago. While administration will continue to closely monitor ways to improve any disparity in gender spending, we feel it is important to exhibit these examples in order to accurately give a full understanding of the numbers in our T35 report.
