Along with this T65 form, you have also received a copy of a revised Title IX Internal Audit Summary for this school. It is important that you review all of the details concerning the analysis of the report submitted.

The Internal Audit Summary will analyze parts 1 and 2 of the three-part test for Title IX compliance, based on a snapshot of the data on the date submitted. Those conclusions are listed. As a result of Covid 19, no determination will be made as to compliance with Test 3. Revisions have been made in this form to clarify the calculation of the underrepresented gender and ensure the preservation of the integrity of the foundational purposes of Title IX. The form also continues to contain notes made to help you determine how calculations were derived and detail the exclusion of certain elements related to Archery, Bass Fishing, and Esports which are true coed sport-activities.

In the first section you will note many factors such as per total participation, total expenditures, participant spending (per gender), and many other factors to be considered as you move forward with future planning. You will also note on Row 13, the determination of the underrepresented gender in your school. This is a critical element in determining Title IX compliance.

The Test 1 (traditionally called the “numbers” test) section again contains guidance as to the number of new participants in the underrepresented gender needed to meet this test. Explanatory notes in the right column should help verify the calculations, which were done by the system based on the submitted data.

The Test 2 (traditionally called the “recent history of expanding sport offerings for the underrepresented gender” test) section contains the information for Test 2 and the calculations were done solely by the system based on the submitted data.

The Test 3 (traditionally called the “accommodating interest and abilities” test) section contains the information for Test 3. This is determined by the audit team based on the analysis of the data provided.

At the bottom of the Title IX Internal Audit Summary is a summary conclusion as to whether or not the school appears to be in compliance with one of the three parts of the tests for Title IX compliance. Adair County High School administered a county interest survey to calculate the interest of sports our student body would like to see implemented within our school system. We saw substantial interest in the athletics of soccer, wrestling, bass fishing, and archery. Bass Fishing and Archery was also a popular answer last year, but we failed to find a coach to guide the sport. We will look to find quality candidates to lead the co-ed sport. We have two local lakes that our team could use for practice as well as host events.

Wrestling, soccer, bass fishing, and archery could all be offered to females and males while significance of interest would determine F/JV/Varsity teams being formulated in the 2024-2025 school year.

The Adair County Administrative Staff will hold an interest meeting for the athletics that entertained the most interest of our student body. This meeting will be offered to all 8-11 graders who will be enrolled in Adair County High School for the 2024-2025 school year. We will offer questions to families, the community, and future athletes to gather further information. These meetings will be held at the beginning of the 2024-2025 school year. The first meeting will be August 26th with a parent follow up meeting on September 16th. If feasible, high school administration would present the addition of sports to the Superintendent and Board of Education.

We noticed bowling had 16 interested in bowling, but this sport is currently not geographically feasible. Adair County does not have a local bowling alley we could rent for students to practice at nor does our campus have the facility. We are hopeful in a few years, we can collaborate with Lindsey Wilson College's bowling program (when they get a facility) and begin a program within Adair County Schools.
