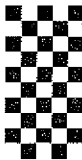

Indian mascot - performs at boy and girl Basketball games.

Pep band - performs at football games and some of the boy's & girl's basketball game.

Everyone must try out even if they were on the team the previous year. They are required to obtain a packet that contains information regarding tryouts and the expectations for the coming year. The packet contains a form that states the rules; requirements (eg. grades according to school policy and KHSAA policy); projected costs of items that they will be able to keep (eg. shoes, hair bows) that must be signed by the person trying out and the parent or guardian. They must have a physical before they can actually try out. We choose a week to teach the material that they will be judged on during tryouts. (eg. jumps, stunting, chants, other skills) A week later we will have tryouts. We use out of county, KAPO5 trained judges to score the tryouts. Anyone who scores 60% of the total score will be part of the team for the next year.
