## **KHSAA TITLE IX POLICY**

### **WRITTEN REGULATIONS ADDRESSING EQUITABLE PROVISION OF AWARDS FOR RECOGNITION OF STUDENT ATHLETES:**

**AWARDS:** Team awards/gifts: Post season awards can be purchased either by boosters or school activity accounts.

- High school Principal or Athletic Director needs to approve post season awards. Awards/gifts values need to be near same total amount per player, not team.

### **POST SEASON BANQUETS FOR STUDENT ATHLETES:**

- Post season athletic team banquets can be either pot-luck or catered at a rate no more than \$15.00 per plate.
- Post season athletic team banquets can be paid for by booster accounts, school activity accounts or individual parents.
- Locations and banquet plans must be approved by high school principal or athletic director to make sure all banquets provide a fair opportunity for all student athletes.
- It is a goal of our school to make post season banquets fair to all athletes involved no matter the sport they play.

### **LODGING:**

- It is recommended that teams place no more than (4) players to a room and not to exceed no more than 4 players per room.
- It is recommended that teams stay in hotels with interior corridors.
- It is recommended that teams stay at hotels that provide a free breakfast when possible to help with cost.
- It is recommended that hotels are approved by high school principal or athletic director to ensure fair and consistent overnight stays for our athletic teams.
