

Bath County High School Athletics

Travel Per Diem Policy

- 1. For those sports that KHSAA reimburses room and meal expenses for post season play, the athletic department will pay those expenses from the contingency fund for the number of people allowed by KHSAA and deposit the KHSAA reimbursement back into the contingency fund. If a team-takes more people than are allowed using the KHSAA standards those expenses will be paid for by the sport's extracurricular account.
- 2. For those sports that KHSAA does not reimburse for room and meal expenses for post season play, the athletic department will pay those expenses from its general account at the same rate KHSAA uses life a team's expenses are more than allowed using KHSAA standards, the difference will be paid for by the sport's school activity account.
- 3. For the All A State Tournament play for all girls and boys sports that requires rooms and meals and the All A reimburses for room and meals... any expenses over the reimbursement amount will be paid by the team's school activity account.
- 4. For All A tournament play that requires rooms and meals and the All A does not reimburse, the entire expense will be paid by the team's school activity account or boosters' club account. Hotel rooms must be a minimum of \$89.99 per room/per night and shall not exceed \$149.99 per room, per night. (Any rooms that do not meet these criteria must be approved by the BCHS athletic director.) Meals shall not be less than \$6 per meal and shall not exceed \$15.00 per student. (Any exceptions to this criteria must be approved by the BCHS athletic director.)

For regular season trips...

- 5. BCHS provides similar travel opportunities for tournaments, out-of-region, and out-of-state events for like teams, girls and boys.
- 6. BCHS provides similar travel opportunities for regular season games for like teams, girls and boys.
- 7. All overnight trips must be Bath County board approved prior to being scheduled.
- 8. Hotel stays will remain equitable for all sports, girls and boys. Hotel rooms must be a minimum of \$89.99 per room/per night and shall not exceed \$149.99 per room, per night. (Any rooms that do not meet these criteria must be approved by the BCHS athletic director.)
- 9. Meals during regular season, district, and region events will be the responsibility of the student athlete and/or booster organization. Meals provided by booster organizations shall not be less than \$6 per meal and shall not exceed \$15.00 per student. (Any exceptions to this criteria must be approved by the BCHS athletic director.)
