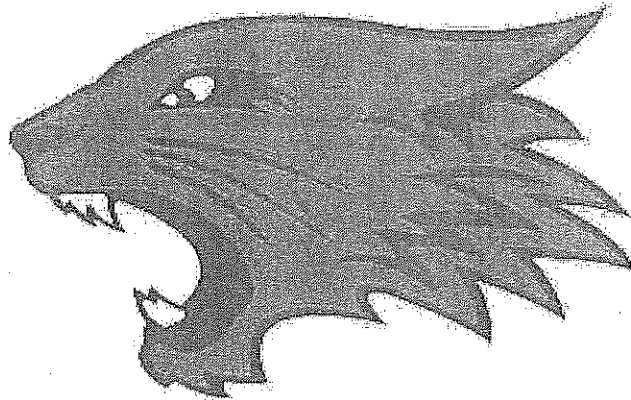

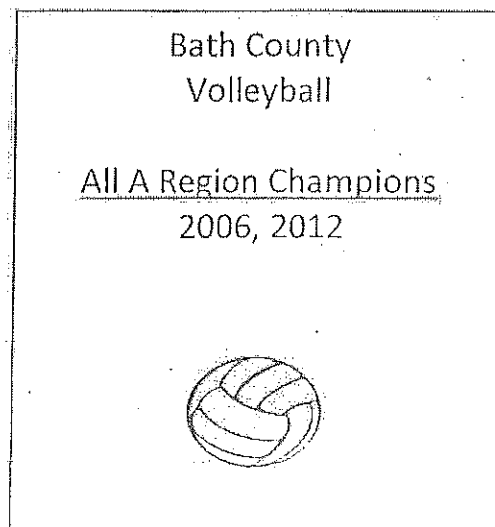
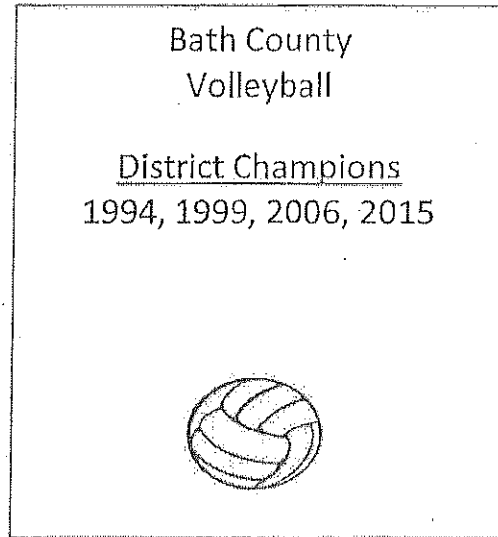

Gym/Field Banner Policy

Gym Banners for Volleyball, Girls' and Boys' basketball, Cheerleading, and Dance will be awarded by year as follows:

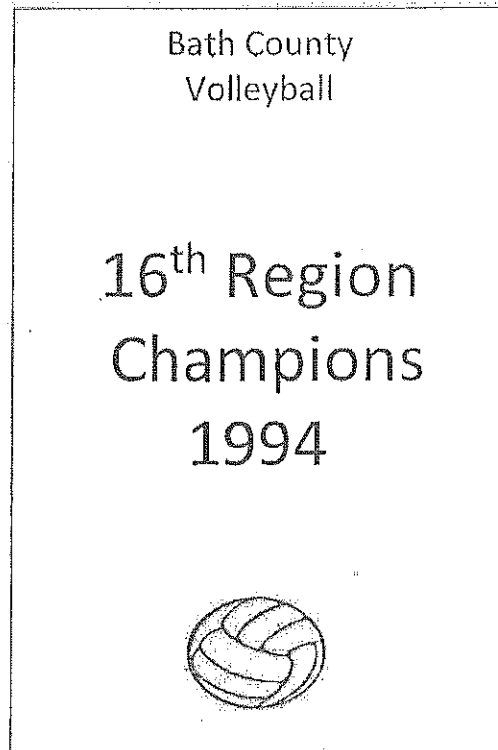
- All award years for "District Championships" and all "All A Region Championships" will be placed on 1 banner.

Example:



- All award years for outright "Regional Championships" will be placed on its own individual banner.

Example:

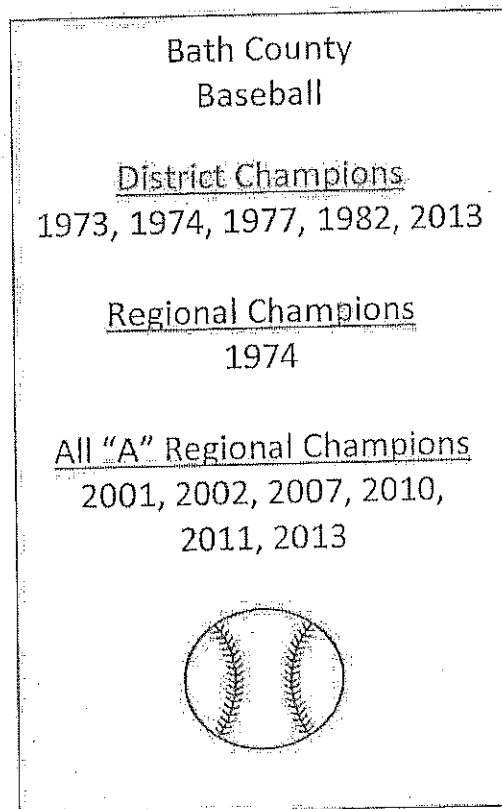


- The BCHS athletic director(s) must approve all teams and individuals that earn recognition worthy of banners/names/ years added to banners in each sport at all venues.
- All criteria worthy for recognition on banners in each sport must be the same for girls' and boys' sports.

Field/stadium banners for Football, Girls' and Boys' Soccer, Baseball, Softball, Cross Country, and Track will be placed at their respective fields and awarded by year as follows:

- Award years for "District Championships", "Region Championships", and "All A Region Championships" will be placed on 1 outdoor banner for each sport at their respective field or stadium.

- The BCHS athletic director(s) must approve all teams and individuals that earn recognition worthy of banners/names/ years added to banners in each sport.

- All criteria worthy for recognition on banners in each sport must be the same for all girls' and boys' sports.

Team/Individual Pictures

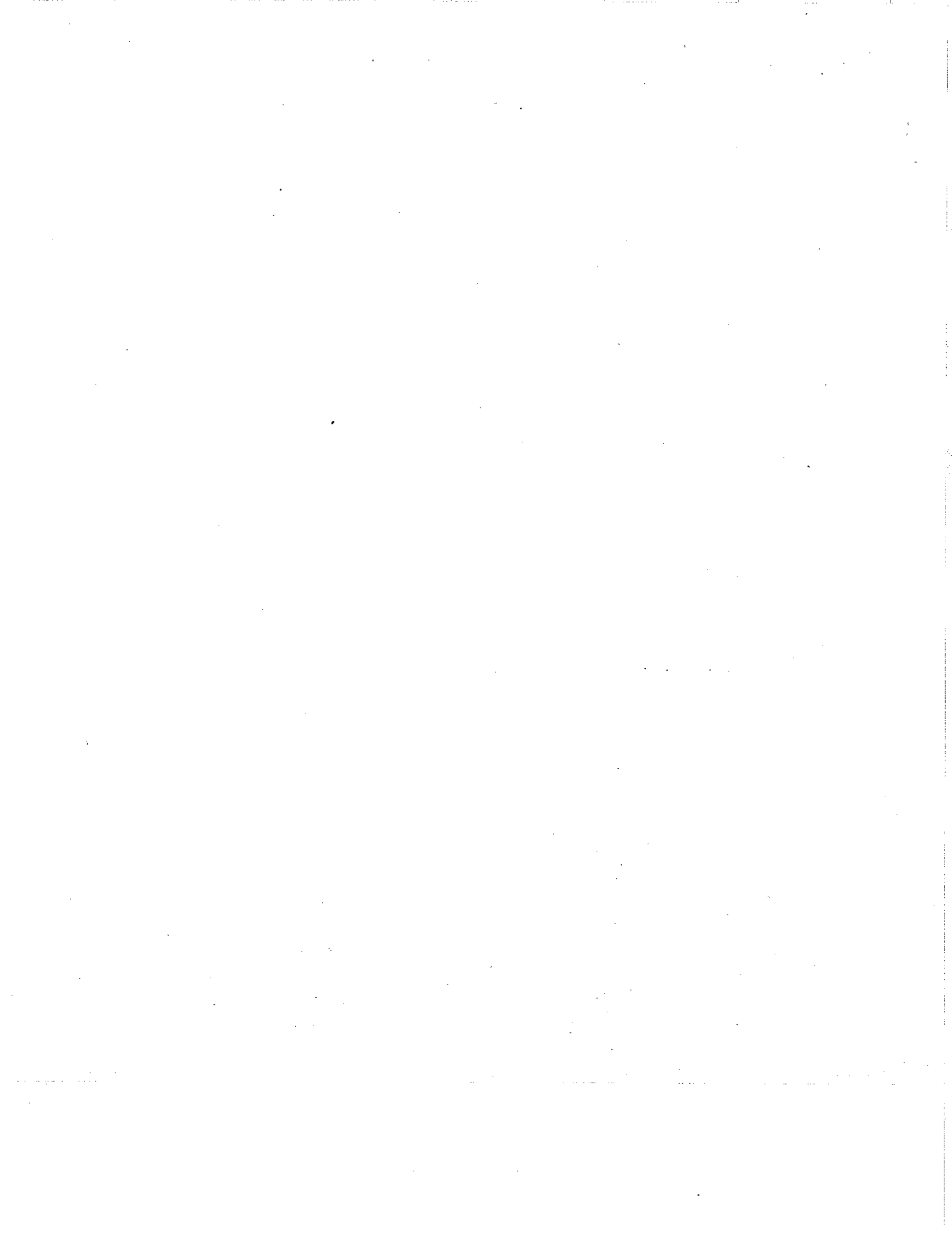
- Team pictures will be placed in gym after winning any KHSAA 16th Region or State Championship.
- Individual names for Boys and Girls 1,000 and 2,000 point clubs in the sport of basketball will be placed on the appropriate banner hanging in the gym.
- The BCHS athletic director(s) must approve all teams and individuals that earn recognition worthy of banners/names/ years added to banners in each sport.
- All criteria worthy for recognition on banners in each sport must be the same for all girls' and boys' sports.

Trophy Case

- All team and individual trophies won by any program will be displayed in the front office of BCHS for a period of two weeks. The trophy will then be placed in the trophy case in the gym for public display. Due to limited space, the main trophy case will be limited to include only 61st District, 16th Region, State, EKC, All "A", 1 and invitational tournament championships.
- The BCHS athletic director(s) must approve all trophies and/or awards that are placed in the trophy case in the gym.

Gender Bias

- There shall not be any banners/trophies/pictures, etc. placed in the gym or trophy case area for boys' if there isn't an equivalent banner/trophy/picture for girls. For example: if the boys' hang a 1000 point banner, there must be one for the girls. However, this does not apply for region winners, etc. There may be more regional championship banners won by one gender as opposed to the other. Also, if one sports' team hangs senior banners, then all sports teams must hang senior banners.

Athletic Award Policy

- BCHS expects and encourages each athletic program to conduct an end of year sports banquet or recognition program.
- The program should take place no later than thirty days after the completion of the season for each sport.
- The responsibility for organizing this recognition program is the responsibility of each head coach.
- Recognition programs/Banquets should be no later than the following dates for each sport:

- Boys and Girls Golf- November 1
- Volleyball, Boys and Girls Soccer- November 30
- Boys and Girls Cross-Country- December 15
- Football- January 15
- Boys and Girls Basketball- April 15
- Cheerleading- April 15
- Baseball and Softball- June 15
- Boys and Girls Track- June 15

- School activity funds and/or booster organizations may be used to purchase trophies, medals, certificates, meal supplies, or other form of recognition.
- The BCHS Athletic Director(s) must approve all awards.
- Any gifts for players given as awards at banquets must cost a minimum of \$5 and shall not exceed \$50 per player. The BCHS athletic director(s) must approve any exceptions.
- The BCHS athletic director(s) will always monitor the banquets to insure that comparable benefits are provided.
- Athletic Bars and Letters will be provided to each qualifying athlete by the coach and will be purchased through the BCHS Athletic Account.

- Bath County High School sets the criterion for lettering and other awards and all coaches should communicate that to the athletes at the beginning of the season.
- The BCHS athletic director(s) must approve any letters or bars that are given to all student athletes.
- The criteria for earning letters and bars are to be the same for both boys' and girls' sports.
