To Whom It May Concern,

Bethlehem High School has embarked on a capital campaign in conjunction with its bicentennial anniversary of continuous service to education in central Kentucky. One of the priorities of the campaign is to build a centralized athletic complex on 40 acres of land acquired through a generous gift. The complex will be developed in three stages based on the availability of funds from the capital campaign.

Phase I will include the additional purchase of 9 acres of land for access and parking plus the initial construction of a soccer/football stadium with track and an accompanying field house. The stadium is designed to seat 800 spectators and accommodate boys and girls soccer, track, football, and all associated JV and freshmen programs. We have not finalized the design of the field house at this date but plans are included to build equal size men's and women's locker facilities. In accordance to school policy, we will not begin actual construction of any of Phase I until 4 million dollars have been raised in cash and pledges. We have raised a little more than 3 million at this point therefore, no actual construction has started. We have completed initial surveys, engineering, and architectural planning for a total cost of approximately \$85,000.

Phase II is planned when an additional 1.5 million dollars have been raised for a total of 5.5 million. Phase II includes the construction of a women's softball field, tennis courts, and soccer and football practice fields. No design work or beginning and ending construction dates have been determined at this point. The softball field will include a regulation, fenced, and lighted facility with a raised pressbox and home and away dugouts.

Phase III will begin when an additional 1.5 million dollars have been raised for an estimated project cost of 7.5 million dollars. Phase III includes a proposed baseball field and indoor practice facility. The baseball field preliminary design includes a regulation, fenced, and lighted facility with a raised pressbox and home and away dugouts. The indoor practice facility will include a multi-purpose area for activities including coed archery, batting cages for baseball and softball, and cheerleading and dance.

Again, all beginning and ending completion dates are based upon the availability of funds acquired through the capital campaign. Optimistically, we would like to begin construction of Phase I in late fall of 2017 or early 2018 with an anticipated completion date of 10 months to a year. We will certainly keep the KHSAA apprised of any confirmed construction dates and designs and will abide by all Title IX regulations.
