

Boone County High School Athletic Department-Post Season recognition policies.

Post-Season Awards/Banquet—Sport Specific

- Season ending awards will be voted upon by Coaches and/or players if awards are given.
- Stats should be included in stat related awards
- Awards such as All-District, All Conference, or All-State should be submitted for school and community recognition.
- Awards will be given at end of year sport specific banquet....the banquet does not have to be extravagant but simply to recognize accomplishments during season.
- Banquet date must be set with two weeks from date of last competition and take place within 30 days of last competition date. If there are circumstances which prevent meeting this timeframe please inform the AD.
- Costs associated with Awards and Banquet must be relayed to the Athletic Director for Title IX documentation.

Senior Recognition

- Senior athletes will be recognized on a "Senior night"which would typically be one of the last few contests of the season.
- If awards/gifts are given they must be in similar cost and quality for each corresponding sport...eg. Boys Soccer and Girls Soccer, etc.
- Senior banners may be placed on the Field or in the gym, cost absorbed by the sport account and/or Athletic Department. Banners must represent each corresponding sport....ie..if there are Girls Soccer banners there must also be Boys Soccer banners, etc.
- Seniors in sports which do not have a typical "game night"such as Cross country, golf, tennis, etc., will be recognized along with other sports. For example....Cross country and Golf seniors would be recognized at the Football or Volleyball senior night.
