over that time that still have remained in Gender Equity, I doubt that this would be an
issue or possible suit.....although there is a lawyer on every corner.
>Yes, admittedly, the pendulum has swung toward the girls and away from boys benefits over
the last seven years because of the KHSAA's direct involvement in the issue. While the
pendulum has now swung back toward the middle of the pendulum for some schools, very
probably (as is the case in most schools) there has been or remains some gender equity
issues that still favor the boys. In my opinion, we have not found in seven years a case
that could be made for reverse gender equity concerns.
