

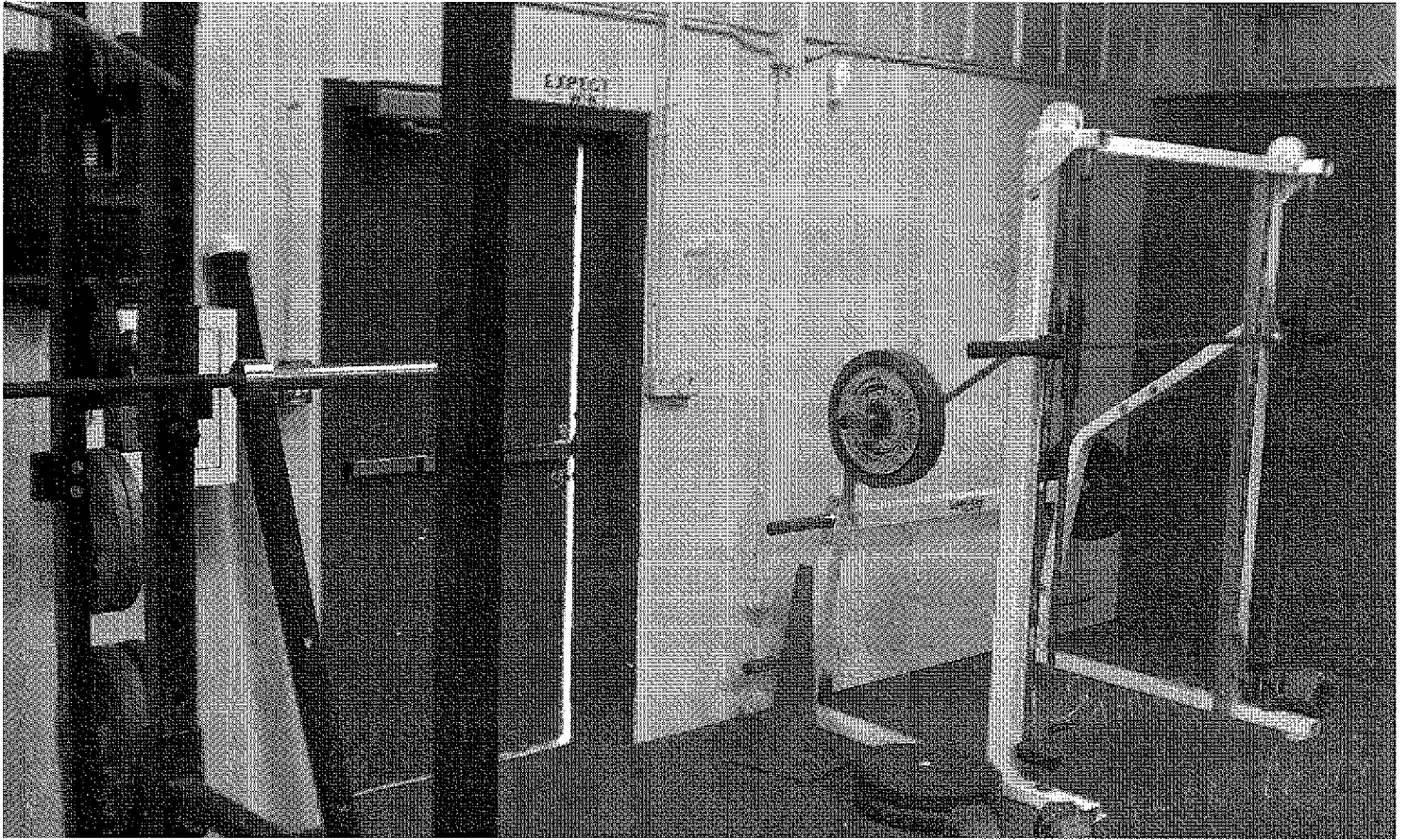

Fall Season:

3:00-4:30- In the athletic training room

4:30 until the end of practice- Football Field

*Make sure you give both the girls and boys soccer coaches your number so if something does happen you can drive over to the YMCA practice fields and help out.

*If there is a soccer game drive out to Cane Ridge Elementary School after football practice with medical kit.

*The athletic trainer does not need to get water for any of the events. Managers will get water for football game and practices and Tony Sosby will get water for soccer games.

Winter Season:

3:00-4:30- In the athletic training room

4:30-8:00- Make rounds between Field house (wrestling) and Gym (basketball practices).

*If there is a basketball game the athletic trainer will need to fill up water and be there an hour before the first game.

*Make sure the wrestling coach has your number in case there is an injury in the field house so you can run down there

*Only need to get water for basketball games not practices

Spring Season:

3:00-4:30- In the athletic training room

4:30- practice ends- Make rounds around baseball, softball, and track.

*Make sure all the coaches have your number so you can go to the designated venues.

*The athletic trainer will need to get water for baseball and softball practices and games.

*If there is a game, the athletic trainer will need to report an hour beforehand.

Athletic Travel and Per Diem Policy

Athletic Per Diem Policy

Per Diem allowances for athletic participants during post-season play shall follow the guidelines listed below:

Breakfast –	5.00
Lunch -	10.00
Dinner -	15.00

If it is a sport in which reimbursement is made to the school by the KHSAA, the school will reimburse the sport's boosters the amount allotted to the school per the meal by the KHSAA (\$5.00/meal at the present). Booster clubs must follow the above-stated guidelines when purchasing/providing meals during regular season and district/regional play, with knowledge that the school is not responsible for reimbursement to the boosters. Regardless of reimbursement or not, the total of \$30.00 per diem per athlete shall not be exceeded.

The principal or athletic director reserves the right to suspend the team's right or booster club's right to purchase meals if the above stated guidelines are not met, or a large inequity between male sports and female sports begins to become evident.

Athletic Travel Policy

Please refer to Bourbon County School Board Policy 09.36 and Bourbon County Schools Field Trip Handbook 2012-2013. Both documents are attached on the following pages.

Concerning teams that have facilities not located on campus, students will be transported by district provided transportation to any off-site practice facility as needed.

Gender Equity Review Committee Meeting

Minutes for January 3rd, 2012

The Title IX Athletic Committee met on January 3, 2012 at 3:30 p.m. in the Board Room at the Central Office. In attendance were: David Horseman, Lana Fryman, Zach Trielobs, Kylie Hilander, Tony Sosby, Jeff Jett, Sarah Wells, Chris Kindred, and Lynne Switzer.

Mr. Horseman requested that Bass Fishing be added to the agenda and the agenda be approved as amended, and it was upon a motion by Mr. Sosby and a second by Ms. Switzer.

The revisit audit report was reviewed by the committee. Mr. Horseman explained the three prong test to the members, and that we met two of three. As a group, we reviewed the items with which we were in compliance.

Individually, we reviewed the areas that the re-visit committee asked that we report back to them on by mid-January and decided or reviewed the following:

1. At all committee meetings we will review spending
2. The committee required that schedules of facility use be posted. Mr. Horseman presented documentation that will be sent to the review committee that practice use schedules and facility schedules have been posted around the building to satisfy that requirement of equitable use.
3. The re-visit committee recommended that the Travel & Per-Diem Policy be consolidated to include all related board and school policy. Mr. Horseman presented a recommended policy to the committee that will outline spending limits/requirements and combines all related board policies, field trip policies, etc. It will be submitted to KHSAA. The group requested that transportation to off-site practice areas be added to the policy submitted. The policy change was approved on a motion by Ms. Switzer and a second by Mr. Sosby. This policy will be added to the permanent Title IX folder.
4. The Booster Club agreement was amended to include prior approval from high school administration for all expenditures by any club that benefits student athletes. The purpose is to ensure compliance with Title IX. Motion for change was made by Ms. Wells and seconded by Mr. Jett.

The committee reviewed finances. Currently we are at 42% vs 57% male / female, which is closer than in previous years. Per athlete spending is currently under \$100 based on projected participate rate, which is down for female athletes. The committee also discussed the plan for completing the T35 and T36 report to explain differences due to facilities and transportation.

Finally, the committee discussed Bass Fishing as a sport, currently the barriers to offering that are being looked into include inspections and insurance.

The meeting was adjourned around 5 p.m. on a motion by Ms. Fryman and a second by Ms. Wells.

ATHLETIC BOOSTER CLUB AGREEMENT

This agreement is entered into by and between the Bourbon County Board of Education (hereafter referred to as "Board") and an entity know as the Bourbon County Booster Club. Through this agreement, the parties intend to set forth the Terms and Conditions under which the Booster Club may operate and associate with students, teachers, coaches and school administrators at Bourbon County High School.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- 1. The Booster Club acknowledges that the Board is responsible for the promotion of education and the general health and welfare of all students attending the Bourbon County Public Schools. In addition, the Booster Club acknowledges that the Board has control and management funds and all public school property in its district and may use its funds and property to promote all public school education (KRS 160.290).**
- 2. The Booster Club acknowledges that its activities may affect compliance with Title IX of the Educational Amendments of 1972 (Title 20. U>S>C> 1681-1687, et seq.) by Bourbon County High School and the Board. Likewise, the Booster Club acknowledges that, as a condition of membership in the Kentucky High School Athletic Association, representatives of Bourbon County High School and the Board must verify that the school complies with Title IX. 702 KAR 7:065, Section 2 (13). Accordingly, the Booster Club agrees to provide all information requested by Bourbon County High School, the Board, or the Kentucky High School Athletic Association for purposed of determining Title IX compliance. The Booster Club further agrees to refrain from engaging in any activity which, in the opinion of the principal or athletic director of Bourbon County High School or the Superintendent of the Bourbon County Public School, adversely affect the school's or the Board ability to comply with Title IX.**
- 3. The Booster Club shall, on or before October 15 of every school year, designate a representative for purposes of communicating with and providing true and accurate information to the Board and Bourbon County High School.**

4. Upon request of the principal or athletic director of the Bourbon County High School, or upon request of the Superintendent of the Bourbon County Public Schools, the Booster Club shall make available a full and complete list of its members.
5. In addition to complying with the requirements of 702 of the Kentucky Administrative Regulations, Chapter 3:130 internal accounting, and all other relevant statutes and regulations, the Booster Club shall, upon the request of the principal or athletic director of the Bourbon County High School, or on the request of the Superintendent of the Bourbon County Public Schools, provide a full and complete accounting of all moneys raised, as well as a full and complete accounting of all moneys expended. In addition, if requested to do so, the Booster Club shall also provide audited financial records concerning its activities.
6. On or before December 15 of every school year, the Booster Club shall advise the principal and athletic director of Bourbon County High School of all fund raising activities planned for the upcoming year. To the extent the Booster Club seeks to engage in additional fund raising activities, it shall give at least ____ days notice of the intended activity.
7. The principal and athletic director of Bourbon County High School and the Superintendent of the Bourbon County Public Schools expressly reserve the right to reject any fund raising activity for any reason. The Booster Club agrees that it shall not engage in any fund raising activity which has not been approved or which has been rejected by the principal or athletic director of Bourbon High School or the Superintendent of the Bourbon County Public Schools.
8. By executing this document through its designated representative, all members officers, and representatives of the Booster Club agree to abide by the terms and conditions set forth below as well as those additional terms and conditions which may be required by the Board. The designated representative of the Booster Club represents and agrees that he/she will provide a copy of this agreement to all members of the Booster Club.
9. For expenditures for student benefit, all Booster clubs must secure high school administration approval.
10. All Booster must adhere to all applicable Redbook and school board policies.

I hereby acknowledge that I am a representative of the Bourbon County High School Booster Club and that I am authorized to act on its behalf. I further agree that this Booster Club and its members shall abide by the Terms and Conditions set forth above, I further agree to immediately report to the principal and athletic director of the Bourbon County High School and to the Superintendent of the Bourbon County Public Schools any violation or breach of this agreement.
