## Boyd County High School Athletics Policies on Awards and Recognition

**Athletic Lettering Policy:** Student athletes, regardless of grade, who participate in approved sports or related athletic programs for Boyd County High School are eligible to receive the following awards, provided by the school, once they have met established lettering criteria and upon the recommendation of the coach/sponsor. If a student athlete voluntarily quits their sport/activity or is dismissed for any reason, they will lose eligibility for lettering awards in that sport/activity during the current sport/activity season. Student athletes are expected to attend all scheduled practices and competitions unless they have the permission of the coach/sponsor to miss scheduled practices or competitions, are injured or ill.

Awards given to eligible student athletes:

Letters and Chevrons:

- First year – chenille Boyd County and a sport/activity-related chevron
- Second and subsequent years – plain chevron

Letterman Jackets:

- Eligible student athlete must be at least a junior or senior and must have lettered in a sport/activity at least two (2) seasons.

Criteria for lettering by sport/activity:

1. **Baseball and Softball** – Enter or play in at least twenty-five percent (25%) of the total **varsity** games played during the regular season. Any type of participation is an entry.
2. **Basketball** – Attend all scheduled **varsity** practices and games for the entire season.
3. **Cross Country** – Compete in at least seventy-five (75%) of the scheduled regular season meets **AND** compete in the Regional Cross Country Meet.
4. **Football** – Attend all scheduled practices and games for the entire season.
5. **Golf** – Play in at least twenty-five percent (25%) of the scheduled **varsity** matches during the regular season.
6. **Soccer** – Play in at least twenty-five percent (25%) of the total **varsity** games during the regular season.
7. **Swimming** – Score at least a total of thirteen (13) points during the **varsity** season meets **AND** qualify for the Regional Swim Meet.

**Awards (Team and Individual):** Awards given to student athletes as a recognition for team or individual accomplishments shall be up to the discretion of the coach and shall not exceed twenty-five dollars (\$25.00) in cost.

**Banquets:** Post-season banquets shall be conducted. Total cost of the banquet shall not exceed one-hundred dollars (\$100.00) per student athlete on the team including food, catering, facility rental, cleanup, and decorations. The total cost of the banquet shall be paid for with booster funds.

**Championship trophies/banners/signs/pictures:** Trophies, banners, signs or pictures won or acknowledging KHSAA post-season competitions shall be publically displayed. Trophies, banners, signs or pictures won or acknowledging non-KHSAA competitions may be displayed at the discretion of the Athletic Director and coach, based upon availability of appropriate space.

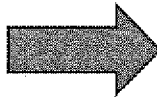
## Hitting Facility Schedule
