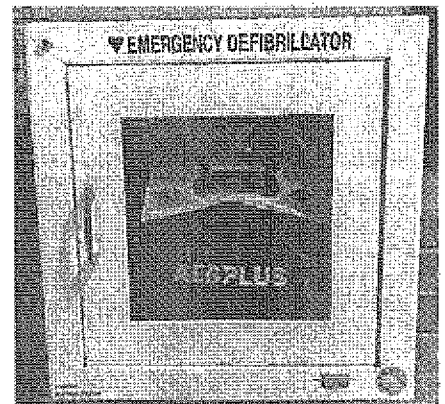

Activating Emergency Medical System:

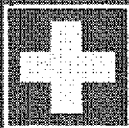
- Designated person (Coach/Administrator) contact 911
- Be prepared to give dispatcher the following information:
 - Address of emergency (see below) and telephone number of phone you are calling from
 - Current condition of student-athlete or spectator (type of injury, conscious or unconscious, etc.)
 - Other information as requested (DO NOT HANG UP UNTIL TOLD TO DO SO BY DISPATCHER)

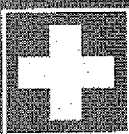
Access through main entrance. Proceed through commons area. Gym will be straight ahead.

- A designated person or school official should make his/her way to unlock and open gates or doors to allow full access for EMT's and escort the emergency responders to the injured person's location.
- Personnel should provide appropriate emergency care until the first responders arrive. Assist with emergency care as needed.
- Athletic staff: If available, please provide EMT's with student-athlete's insurance information and medical history.
- A parent, Coach, or School Administrator should accompany a student-athlete during EMS transportation.
- The Certified Athletic Trainer, Coach, or School Administrator shall contact the student-athlete's parents/guardians if not present at the event.

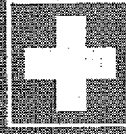


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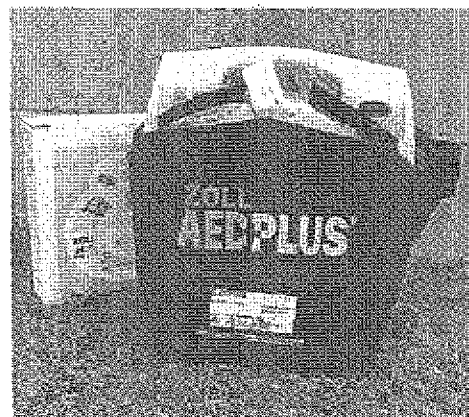
BRECKINRIDGE COUNTY HIGH SCHOOL FOOTBALL/SOCCER FIELD

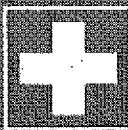

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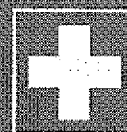


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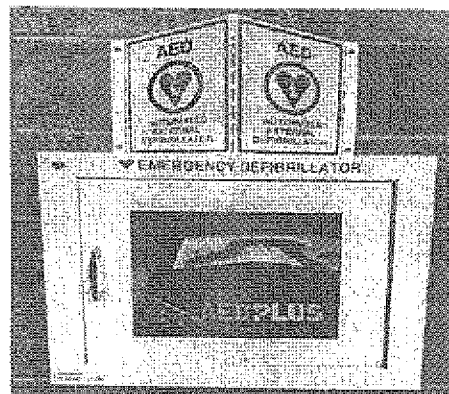
BRECKINRIDGE COUNTY HIGH SCHOOL ALL-PURPOSE BUILDING

Breckinridge County High School Athletic Travel Policy

Mileage for all trips will be calculated using Google Maps, with the start address of BCHS and the end address of the athletic venue used for competition.

Breckinridge County High School will be responsible for the following:

- Cost of transportation using Breckinridge County Public School buses or vans (vans can only transport 6 or fewer student/athletes and are only utilized during unique/special situations)
- All competition trips that are required for its participants must have a bus/van offered for its members.
- Any use of a charter bus for team travel must be approved by the BCHS Principal.

Breckinridge County High School will not be responsible for the following:

- Student-Athlete and Coach meals

Overnight Trips - All overnight trips must be pre-approved by BCHS Administration. Out of state trips must be approved by the Breckinridge County Board of Education.

- Hotel rooms will be paid for by BCHS
 - Mid to high level lodging (Hotels with at least a 4 star rating) will be utilized and all hotel reservations must be approved by the BCHS Principal
 - It is requested that coaches reserve rooms within controlled access interior corridors
 - It is requested that the hotel reservation include a free continental breakfast
 - It is requested that 3-4 student-athletes be assigned to each room
- Meals will be the responsibility of the student-athletes and coaches

Breckinridge County High School Awards and Recognitions

- It is requested that each team host a post-season banquet. The BCHS commons area is offered (free of charge) for all banquets and the majority of banquets are held at BCHS.
- Each individual coach is allowed to choose what awards will be given out during the season and at post-season banquets. The awards will be certificates, plaques, trophies, etc. It is requested that each team give out awards. It is requested that each team spend a minimum average of \$10 per student/athlete on awards but no more than an average of \$20 per student/athlete.
- BCHS is not responsible for purchasing food for banquets, awards night, etc. The costs of all banquet meals is the responsibility of the student/athletes and parents.
- All awards will be purchased by the BCHS Athletic Department.
- There should be NO monetary awards or gift cards given.
- All student-athletes will receive an athletic letter with the sport's emblem. Each student-athlete will receive one letter regardless of the number of sports in which they compete. If they play multiple sports, they will receive emblems of the other sports.
- All varsity student-athletes will receive a bar for each season of varsity competition.
- All senior student-athletes will receive a plaque with an athletic letter and the emblem for that sport and bars for each season of varsity competition in that sport and they will receive an individual banner that will be displayed at their respective home competition venues (ex. gym, football field, baseball field, etc.)
